The future for digital textile printing By Jack Gocher

The UK dye sublimation print market – Covid, signage and diversification

In recent years inkjet dye sublimation has become an increasingly important print technology for fabric materials and signage. In 2021 however users in the UK and around the world are having to adjust to the new realities of markets recovering from Covid, where there is less short term demand.

John Nelson, Editor at Smithers, says "Data from Smithers shows that the world value for such work rose from €6.99 billion in 2017, to a projected €8.41 million in 2019, with annual increases of over 10% seen for most of the 2010s. Overall volume reached a projected 1.72 billion square metres in 2019. The majority of this is for apparel, especially sports and swimwear."

For both interior and exterior display applications the UK printed 9.85 million metres square of dye sublimation material in 2018, making it the second largest market in Europe, after Germany. The most important dye sub display media are interior banners and soft signage, scenery and backdrops, outdoor soft signage, and flags and banners.

Nelson continues, "Overall graphic arts have seen a big fall in demand over 2020. Closing of non-essential retail, cancellation of sports and other live events, and the suspension of corporate events and trade shows have all had a direct impact; while lockdown orders have forced diminished advertising budgets towards online media. Smithers latest scenario modelling finds that across all print processes, global signage and point of sale works fell by 12.8% in 2020, relative to 2019."

While public events have been closed, DIY has become a more popular pastime across Covid-19 lockdowns. Household dye sublimation printing - including wallcoverings, upholstery, carpets, bed linen, window and shower curtains provide a diversification opportunity, as consumers prioritise home decoration while hospitality venues remain shut, normal office working is suspended, and public events are postponed. With nonessential retail only now starting to reopen, the pandemic has placed a premium on ecommerce sales channel, and also given scope to implement web-to-print design platforms for shoppers to personalise designs for their own interior décor. This also supports the further transition from analogue to inkjet print systems in large format installations.

John Nelson adds, "A second area that has seen elevated demand is bespoke novelty items, such as mugs, smartphone covers, T-shirts and tote bags; which also can use dye sub presses. A pre-Christmas

survey estimated that UK shoppers would spend £750 million on personalised gifts over the 2020-2021 festive period."

A third direct diversification market has been created by the surging demand for facemasks, and in particular corporate branded designs – where the dye sub print process gives enduring graphics that can resist repeat washing and treatment with harsh cleaning chemicals.

The challenge during Covid has been to produce these quickly enough to keep up, as demand has far outstripped installed capacity. In one example, Roland DG dye sub equipment owned by the La Cocina Gráfica was used to set up a print production line that was able to manufacture 200 masks per hour in the north western Spanish city of Vigo.

"The route out of Covid-19 is still unclear, although efforts across Europe are benefiting from vaccinations, and the prospect of warmer weather to minimise virus spread. Despite having the highest death toll in Europe, the UK has managed vaccine deployment well and plans for relaxation of restrictions will potentially boost demand for dye sublimation signage, including more social distancing decals; but also more facemasks, and other personal protective equipment," concludes John Nelson.

Dispersal inks are either referred to as low energy or high energy. Low energy sublimation means that an image or pattern is firstly printed to a transfer paper, which is then taken off the printer and transferred to the polyester fabric by means of a heat press. High-energy sublimation means that the ink is directly printed onto a polyester textile after which, it will need to go through a heat press for final fixation.

Platt adds, "CMYUK's Binder 4 showcases its natural fabrics, a comprehensive range that come in a wide range of different weights of cotton and linen blends suited for both décor and fashion. These natural materials have a specific coating that improves colour strength and fixation, allowing pigment inks to be directly printed onto the fabric. Post printing, pigment inks need to be fixed with heat at temperatures of around 165°C. Pigment printed natural fabrics is the fastest growing print method, representing an affordable and easy route for PSPs wanting to expand their offerings. This is because only a heat press is required to turn a printed textile into a viable product. Printing reactive inks onto natural materials on the other hand involves a far longer and involved process, as finishing also requires steam washing and drying.'

The calender press

A heat press is vital to the dye-sublimation process as it ensures permanency – resulting in high quality durable prints that display vibrant colour, crock and washfastness. "CMYUK has recently launched the VERTEX, a new hybrid transfer printing calender from Klieverik. This is a highly affordable heat press with a compact footprint, specifically designed to cater for these new market sectors. Optimised for ease of use, VERTEX is able to cope with the widest range of Polyester (PES) fabrics," says Platt.

He continues, "VERTEX is also a perfect companion for heat fixing natural fabrics printed with pigment inks and the DuraVibe[®] range of soft furnishing textiles from CMYUK, which have been specifically developed for use with HP Latex ink technology, affording all HP Latex owners the potential to enter the soft furnishings, homewares and interior markets by providing printed items that are fit for purpose – durable, high rub-fastness and the ability to withstand frequent washing."

What are the key reasons for digital textile printing's increasing popularity?

When looking at the Garment Decoration market, screen printing has been the most commonly used production technology for many years. Things are changing though. Screen printing typically comes with high set-up costs, complex workflow, and environmental concerns. The rise of e-commerce and on-demand print are other factors that mean analogue technology is unlikely to continue to dominate the market.

The promotional goods market and its associated print requirement have run under the radar of the print industry due to the high fragmentation of product, print technology, and distribution channels. However, the demand is starting to shift from mass market, low value promotional products to higher-value personalised products. Since 2013, the promotional goods market has grown only 2% per year on average. By contrast, the personalised goods segment has been growing rapidly by 10% annually since 2013. Taken together the worldwide value is an extraordinary €57 billion. (Fespa census 2017)



The company was an early adopter of DTG garment printing, which enables unique designs to be printed directly to Tshirts, sweatshirts and other products at high speeds and low set-up costs. However, competition from start-ups was squeezing prices and Identity Printing considered leaving the fashion market until it was approached by high-end brand MisRep. Instead of simply taking on the printing contract, Identity Printing invested in the fashion brand and now owns a 50 per cent share.

"When MisRep came to us we were initially sceptical," says Zahid Ali, Production Manager, Identity Printing. "What we didn't realise was that one of the guys is a design genius and the other a social media expert. Together

we've created a high-end fashion brand that has achieved an amazing turnover and a social media buzz, including 43,000 followers on Instagram."

The material is manufactured using the most efficient, green methods possible and maintains the high levels of quality, durability and versatility that our customers expect."

Soft signage and fabrics

Generally speaking, printed soft signage and fabric is a cost effective and environmentally friendly way to create eye-catching displays that are impactful yet lightweight. Innotech's printable textiles under its Vertex brand name are suitable for dye sublimation and direct printing with UV-C or Latex technology up to 3.2m. The Vertex range can be used for many applications including flag displays, tension frames, tents, illuminated lightbox displays, backdrops and more.

"Printed soft signage and fabrics are definitely one of the fastest growing areas of our business and all evidence would suggest this is likely to continue," says Dallow, adding, "Textiles are, quite literally, so much more flexible than traditional printed signage. They can be applied in many more ways, which can be more practical than standard signage, such as barriers, dividers and vertical covers. They also can be designed to look great, fitting into an environment with great versatility and in a visually pleasing and natural way."

Signs saving the sea

The burden of single use plastic has created huge pressure on the world's natural environment and this has been highlighted by the horrific scenes of plastic waste causing untold damage to marine wildlife and beaches across the planet. There is something very pleasing to be part of an industry that is doing something very real about this awful situation and if more industries do the same, we have a real chance of turning the tide on the climate catastrophe.

How is it done?

Preventing single use plastic bottles from going into the ocean by turning it into Vertex Marine is a 7-part process, which is itself adopting green and efficient production techniques.

It starts with baling - empty plastic bottles are sorted, crushed and baled at a recycling centre and moved to the manufacturing plant where the bales are separated by a superfast vibration machine and labels are removed by friction. The separated bottles are ground down into flakes and are washed and cleaned to remove any excess fluid, labels or caps, which are then turned into small plastic pellets through the use of a vented extruder.

These pellets are transported to the yarn manufacturing facility, where they are melted down and spun into a polyester yarn. This yarn is woven into the finished Vertex Marine product. A display fabric at heart, Vertex Marine is designed to be used as promotional tablecloths, tube display backdrops, like Innotech's TEXstyle Straight system, or other frontlit applications.

Kieran Dallow concludes, "To put this in perspective, one roll of 3.2m x 100m Vertex Marine material uses just under 4,000 plastic bottles, which otherwise could have made their way into the ocean. This is all done, without losing any of the qualities of a virgin polyester yarn giving you just as good quality print finish when you use dye-sublimation, UV-C or Latex printers."





How important is UK manufacture in the current economic climate?

The protective screens were one and a half metres wide and nearly one metre high. The clear screens featured messages to explain the social distancing measure and direct customers to small waist-height windows for transactions.



A game of four halves for carbon neutral installation for EFL

MacroArt has completed an installation of more than 3000 m2 of graphics and signage at the EFL Papa John's Trophy Finals Wembley Weekender held at Wembley Stadium in March.

As part of MacroArt's drive for carbon neutrality across its business, the seat kills (which represented over 2500 m2 of the whole project) were produced from the PVC-free material Kavalan from CMYUK. This immediately reduced the project's overall carbon footprint by more than 30% when compared with traditional banners, says the company.

Following the completion of the event, all graphics and signage were recovered by the MacroArt team and returned for recycling in the relevant waste streams.

In addition, the carbon footprint of the materials used for the event was calculated and offset by MacroArt's investment in UK Woodland Carbon Units to deliver a net zero carbon impact.

"Sustainability is key to many of our clients and providing graphics that have a minimal impact on the environment while maintaining performance is a game changer for today's events," says sales director Matt Guise.

Held on the weekend of 13-14 March, two finals in two days presented the

installation team with the extra challenge of rebranding sections of the stadium overnight to ensure the team-specific branding was in place. Walls around the holding area, team dugouts and Spot the Ball seat kills were removed and updated after the first game by the MacroArt installation team.

Despite this, the huge project was delivered on time for each of the finals which saw Salford City and Sunderland AFC crowned winners for the 19/20 and 20/21 trophies. "It was very rewarding to work with an organisation as committed as we are to carbon neutrality and the team at EFL supported our efforts at very stage," concludes Matt.

"We look forward to continuing our work with them and it is clear that reducing our carbon footprint will remain at the very top of the league table for both our organisations."
