

On page 32 there's an interesting article on a 15 year old lad who's living the dream and racing in the Junior Ginetta Championships - it's all about his car being wrapped in a new kind of vinyl that's extra thin, lightweight, aerodynamic and durable. It entrigued me, so I read a little more into it, on the manufacturers website, they give the example of coating a 747 jetliner requiring 2,500 fewer pounds of paint than using traditional sprayed applications, and because graphics are embedded within the AERO™ paint film, there's less drag. That's quite a saving through efficiency for every flight. I am curious as to how much more we'll see of this product coming to vehicle wrapping of performance cars.







TUTORIAL Neon Flex

A step by step Neon Flex tutorial

Spectron LED have updated their Neon Flex range, so you now have the option to have cut points of 10mm as well as still 25mm, which means that the length of Neon Flex needed can be more accurately tailored to the length required to the nearest 10mm. Ivan Lew, Managing Director of Spectron LED goes into detail of how to install this



Prepare your artwork to scale and either use a CNC machine to router out your back panel, or cut the letters out of self-adhesive paper and apply as a stencil to the panel (this will also protect the panel from glue marks). If using a CNC, we recommend using a 5mm thick acrylic back panel with a 3mm deep channel.



Cut the neon into pieces as per your design. The 10mm cut marks are visible on the side. Aim to make as few connections as possible as this will speed up the process and give a neater nish. For tight bends mitre cut the Neon Flex, take care to avoid damage to the LED.



Each piece of neon must be connected to make a circuit. Drill holes in the panel where you want to join one length of neon to another so that you can feed the wires through the back. Using the clear ready tinned fine cable it will not be noticeable when illuminated.



When you're ready to start joining pieces of neon together, you will need to expose the solder points on the PCB. Add some solder to the soldering points, then place the tinning cable on top. Heat with the solder iron gently until the tinning cable connects and sticks



Tinning cable has a gold and silver conductor with a clear outer sleeve. If the gold is connected to the positive solder point and the silver to negative solder point, keep this consistent through out your project.



Use a 12v driver fitted with crocodile clips to test the soldering. If the neon doesn't illuminate, check the wire has been soldered securely and that the positive and negative wire aren't touching.



Using Mitre Bond glue, run the activator pen along the bottom surface of the Neon Flex (and one side of the join) and apply small drops of glue to the panel, approximately 20mm apart.



Feed the cable through the hole that is to be joined to the next length and position the Neon Flex. It will bond almost instantly so take extra care



Measure the next length and solder on the ready tinned cables on one end.



Solder the new length to the previous length and test with the LED driver.

Continue this process until all pieces are in place.



When complete, use the same glue for cable management.



Always keep the run of the Neon Flex as short as possible. For extra long letters use multiple power points or connect in the middle with power to left and right.

"We've quadrupled, if not more, the amount of material we can print for one contract."

Ben Ashdown, Managing Director at Magna Signs in Nuneaton, sums up the extraordinary impact of the wide-format hybrid 3.2-metre Agfa Anapurna H3200i LED, purchased through Josero. The main challenge facing Magna Signs was volume; there was too much demand for the business to meet in-house, particularly as the volume from a large contract with one of their key clients was increasing.

However, allowing the business to boost capacity wasn't the only advantage of this new addition to Magna's inventory. Ben adds: "It opens up a few different avenues of what we can print, things we couldn't do in house before because this is the first UV hybrid machine that we've had. So, it just allows us to do a little bit more."

The Anapurna H3200i LED permits Magna to work with a wider range of media,

potentially opening up new doors to different projects. Ben continues: "Having a hybrid with built-in roll-to-roll UV machine enables us to print media that we couldn't print with solvent. We couldn't meet that demand before, but now we can do it all in house."

The majority of that work involves printed Correx boards as part of the contract with their key client, although other projects such as construction hoardings and property signage go through the machine.

When on the hunt for the right piece of kit to meet their needs, Magna turned immediately to Josero due to a longstanding relationship with Managing Director Sarah Winterbottom. Despite COVID restrictions hampering the usual face-to-face process, the acquisition went off without a hitch. "It was here within two weeks, and I couldn't fault the experience of the build and support from Josero," adds Ben. "The support with service and build from Agfa was really good, too." Ben and Magna will also be able to take advantage of Agfa's partnership with Profitable Print Relationships, which is providing added value business coaching to new Agfa customers.



PressOn says it has secured several innovative graphics jobs during the uncertain pandemic period - following some spectacular pre-COVID projects - using its . Installed in April 2019 and updated to the 2020 edition a few months later, the HP Latex printer has enabled PressOn to meet demands for fast turnaround, exceptional quality and sustainability.

Andy also notes the impact of wallpaper graphics at the offices of HBD Systems - a producer of double-glazing solutions - and PMP Recruitment respectively. HBD Systems' campaign saw the HP Latex machine produce vibrant photographic reproductions of stunning views, while the PMP job involved branding the office space with a bold geometric design inspired by beehives.

"These were two different jobs on onepiece wallpaper," he explains. "For HBD Systems, the print was vibrant and the end result was exactly what the client was looking to achieve."

With regards to the PMP Recruitment work, Andy adds: "The print transformed the newly built office walls and showed the key values of the company."

Both before and during the pandemic,

PressOn worked with historic department store Harrods on a number of projects. These included preparing the Knightsbridge landmark for its reopening in June 2020, which required the removal of 549 linear metres of vinyl window graphics and the installation of new borders, logos and graphics - and all in under six hours.

As to the future, PressOn Managing Director Andy Wilson is looking ahead to more exciting projects as the business continues to recover from the pandemic.

"Much of the work that had been postponed has begun to return," he says. "Working with HP Latex printers for the past twelve years has meant we are able to respond to customer demands for short-turnaround, high-spec work on so many different materials. Andy Wilson also recalls a job for the Harrods fine jewellery department ahead of Christmas 2019: "We're pretty proud of the project; it really stood out. The idea with the campaign was that it would be a midnight sky design and areas were purposely left with minimal or no ink coverage to allow the light from the illuminated onyx it was installed onto to show through, adding to the effect."



The PressOn team installed a new graphic in the same area in 2020, using artwork developed in a joint collaboration between PressOn's artwork team and Harrods' designers.







ELECTRONIC SIGNAGE Feature

An Electronic View

Electronic Signage has increased massively over recent years and is now very much part of the fixtures and fittings of many public spaces. It may be that you don't actually need a full CMS. A simple USB stick that uploads to the existing built-in media player every professional monitor has today might just as easily do the job. Trust me, if you can keep it simple then do."

Of course, it's not always appropriate to take this route. When a client requires a number of screens over multiple sites or even multiple screens at the same site then a cloud-based CMS will be required to manage this effectively. To control the scheduling, playlists, many different types of content and the ability to immediately update and refresh is something a USBbased solution simply can't do.

According to Rushton a cloud-based CMS is the only way to go. "It is important to note that in order to deliver these solutions you don't need to have the slightest bit of knowledge about Java-Script or what a full stack programmer does. Here at Kapow, we rely on our staff and expert suppliers. So, the first thing to do when looking at the CMS software that you're planning to sell on is to look at the level of expertise in your business. You then need think about whether your CMS provider has the infrastructure and reputation to support you through demanding times as well as the good."

He adds, "A 24-48 hour turnaround on a support ticket system simply does not cut the mustard in this world. Once a digital sign isn't working correctly, the effects are instantly seen by everyone, including your customer and theirs. You will be expected to react quicker than many CMS support teams are reacting to you. If you have the set up to handle at least 50% of issues inhouse, then you are in a much better place to protect your business relationships and secure your own future."

According to Chris Rushton, if your customer requires access to the CMS then make sure the system you propose is simple for them to understand and use, unless they want to commit to days and weeks of training. "Of course you can charge for this training, which brings us to the important question of money. Will you earn a decent profit from providing a CMS to your customers? If you look at it from the point of view of simply selling on licenses then you're going to have to be selling a lot if you're considering retiring early."

It is interesting to look at this from a printing perspective, explains Chris, "If you're sold a printer, that company will be hoping to increase their own sales by supplying you with inks and media. The CMS is like the consumables for electronic signage. It allows you to sell additional items, like new template design ideas, from stills to basic animation and video, which would help keep your studio busy.



You could even be charging a fee to manage the whole thing or simply providing holiday cover. Most clients won't have more than one person running the show for them."

Chris Rushton concludes, "If it all sounds like a big jump that's too scary to make, then of course you could talk to a company like mine, Kapow Network. We own and run our network of screens and help businesses like yours migrate to

selling digital signage to your customers. We understand the mindset of printers and signmakers, so speak a language you'll understand. 

Bristol City Council designed a series of 2m x 1.1m (6.6ft x 3.6ft) footprint-style graphics for use in high traffic areas of the city ahead of non-essential shops reopening in mid-April.

The printed graphics had to be safe for use underfoot. The Council specified they should have a proper slip rating, meaning they were safe for use in busy areas that could be exposed to wet weather, including high streets and other retail settings.

To meet these challenges, the Council turned to N3 Display Graphics in Bristol. As a long-time user of Drytac materials, N3 Display Graphics quickly identified as the ideal solution for the project.

Polar Street FX is a PVC-free, aluminium print media suitable for both outdoor floor and wall graphics, without the need for lamination. The slip-resistant printable film can be applied to ground or wall surfaces



such as brick, concrete, asphalt or any other low energy surfaces. Polar Street FX holds a 'Low Slip Potential' 72 PTV according to the EN 13036-4 Pendulum Test. In the UK, the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) only recognises slip ratings based on the Pendulum Test Method.

N3 Display Graphics Director Nigel Walker explains: "The Council specified that we

use aluminium-backed slip rated material so Polar Street FX was the ideal choice for the job."

Polar Street FX is printable with ecosolvent, latex or UV technology, making it a flexible choice. For this project, the giant footprint graphics were printed on two HP Latex 360 printers, resulting in a series of creative graphics that have proved a huge hit with shoppers since being installed at the end of March 2021.

N3 Display Graphics cut the graphics into the curved footprint shape with its Zünd cutter with double edged tungsten blades, which was easily able to handle the strong-wearing nature and toughness of the Polar Street FX aluminium backing.

A film-based paint, AERO is highly durable, 50% lighter than traditional sprayed paint, and easy to apply. The Ginetta was prepared for the 2021 season by Cheshire print service provider, , whose capabilities range from screen printing, through web design and business stationery, to wide format printing and high-end vehicle graphics.

Offering the aesthetic advantages of paint but with the benefits of a colour change film, Nettl Crewe & Nantwich used its to add further value by incorporating printed elements into the design, to reproduce sponsor logos and branding directly onto the material.

"AERO is finding real traction in the motorsport sector," says Mark Jones, Nettl

Crewe & Nantwich managing director. "From a local motocross outfit, to Max as an up-and-coming racing driver, right through to Le Mans and F1 teams, we're seeing multiple advantages of choosing Aero as the means of applying colour, branding and livery. With its strong ecocredentials, we're also experiencing good take-up from environment-first businesses with large fleets of liveried vehicles who want a long-lasting, PVC-free wrapping solution."

Expertly balancing his motorsport career with the demands of schoolwork, Dodds' involvement in the preparation of his car extends beyond the task of piloting it around a track at speeds of up to 170kph. Having started out racing karts at the age of 4, he's graduated through various motorsport classes and during this time, become more engaged with the valuable task of reporting back to his engineers on his car's performance. "Being able to let my engineers know the improvements to the handling and feel of the car is important for them in how they set it up," says Dodds. "I like to be involved with the team and have an input, and the new AERO film has made a difference not just to how the car looks, but in how it drives."

Nettl's Mimaki UCJV300 uses LED UV cured ink to print to a wide range of materials and with its dense, bright white ink, overprinting onto a coloured material such as the black AERO product used on

Dodds' car ensures vibrant results for sponsor logos and branding. The ability to reprint individual panels means that in the event of a bump or scrape the whole car doesn't need painting and with wheel-to-wheel action expected at the season's 25 races, its scuff resistance will be appreciated too. "AERO is an incredible 17,000 times tougher than regular paint," says Jones. "Combine this with the excellent rub resistance of the Mimaki ink and we hope to not have to make too many changes to the wrap during the season."

The UCJV300 sits alongside a raft of other Mimaki technology at the company's recently acquired premises in Crewe. Already a 15-strong team, Nettl Crewe & Nantwich was established in 2017, and invested in its Mimaki hardware through authorised Mimaki partner, . It's no surprise to the company's general manager, Kirsty Reader that it's being put to such creative use.

"The breadth of the Mimaki UCJV300's capabilities is one of the reasons it's such a popular solution and we're pleased to see it become an important part of Nettl's print capabilities," states Reader. "We wish Max and his team well with the coming season and eagerly await seeing the livery on our TV screens this summer."

Races from the nine weekends of the Ginetta Junior Championship will be shown live on ITV4 so the pressure to get the car looking its best was on for Jones' team of wrapping experts at Nettl. "Our launch event gave us the chance to show off the new graphics to the team's sponsors and we look forward to it appearing just as polished when Max lines up on the grid at Brands Hatch, Silverstone, Donnington and other legendary circuits around the UK this season," confirms Jones.

The opportunity to race at such prestigious venues is just part of the appeal for Dodds. "I'm excited about the 2021 season, racing across the UK and getting behind the wheel of the new car," he concludes, and his calm approach ensures he's not getting too carried away. "I've learnt over the years to take it one race at a time, and having such a great looking car that's already performing so well is a big confidence boost to the whole team."

What are the latest trends in large format Inks and Media?

InkTec is a global manufacturer of inkjet ink, JETRIX printers and media for the indoor and outdoor advertisement market. Peter Davidson, Sales Director, says, "At InkTec Europe we are experiencing a resurgence in the demand for aqueous inks which is being driven by businesses focussing on more ecological print solutions for many indoor and outdoor applications. This has been particularly noticeable by the significant growth in sales of dye sublimation and pigmented aqueous inks."

During the pandemic InkTec's priority has been to keep supporting customers through-out this challenging time. This has proved particularly important for those needing a consistent ink supply. Davidson continues, "With everything going on, InkTec Europe has obviously been impacted by raw material costs just like other manufacturers. However, by being able to consolidate our production approach, we have decided to absorb these additional costs to support our customers and help them recover as everyone emerges from the pandemic. The feeling was that it was important to try to limit price increases on essential materials like inks, when many are struggling to move forwards."

"So, during the last 12-18 months we have put a number of new efficiency measures in place at the production stage, which has enabled us to streamline our manufacturing processes, resulting in their being no need for us to increase ink prices in 2021. This may be a surprise to the


market; however, it has been warmly welcomed by our customers who are already under immense business pressures," adds Davidson.

The media message

Peter Davidson says that InkTec have long been focused on reducing the volume of media being produced using unrecyclable materials. "In fact, we have eliminated PVC from our display portfolio which means that 100% of media produced by InkTec is now made from polyester and polypropylene materials which can be recycled. While as a business, we continue to be focused on ensuring that the raw materials are as 'green' as they can be the challenge is how 'green' they become once they are used.'

Good examples of this are InkTec's new anti-scratch textured roll up media, which does not require lamination after printing, and the recently introduced TEX-RA fire rated self-adhesive polyester fabric wall covering. Both are first class products made from recyclable materials.

InkTec's belief is that striving to be greener should just be the norm. This philosophy and approach has long been talked about, but the issue now is how the printing industry creates a circular economy. The question is: once the product has been used, how can the cost of de-inking and recycling it, in order to create an effective re-purposed product,

be easily and cost effectively achieved?

Davidson concludes, "Sadly, the current situation means the resulting recycled product ends up being of a much lower value than the cost of processing it to reach that state. So, while here at InkTec Europe we are committed to providing quality products that can be recycled in their raw form, the majority of our industry, from the supplier to the end user, have yet to find an acceptable financial and practical means of how they can be effectively recycled."



Why is the industry moving away from PVC media?

It does seem that the large format print industry is really taking the environmental challenge seriously. 




