

Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED from i-Sub flies the flag in Cambridgeshire

House of Flags has invested in a 2.5m-wide Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED hybrid printer as it looks to branch out into printing on more rigid materials.

Since 1977 the company has specialised in (unsurprisingly) flags, and now has three different offices spread across the UK, including its Cambridgeshire headquarters. The company processes more than 7000 orders annually and boasts a turnover of more than £4 million.

It has delved deep into the world of digital printing in order to produce top soft-signage products for its customers. However, as the industry evolves the company was also keen to investigate other potential uses for digital technology, including printing onto more rigid substrates.

In fact, when Adam Moore joined the team earlier this year as Studio and Print Production Manager, one of the things he was specifically tasked with was investigating machinery currently on the market that could help House of Flags diversify its product range.

House of Flags already had a longstanding relationship with Agfa reseller i-Sub and had previously purchased several different machines from them including a number of dye sublimation print solutions and a digital cutting table. "I was extremely impressed with the Agfa," Adam says. "The user interface was simple and user friendly and the machine



itself is very versatile. We've gone for the 2.5m model as the 3.2m would have been a little bit too much machine for us at the present, but its performance has been out of this world and the installation was the quickest and easiest I've ever been involved with."

One particular attribute of the Agfa Anapurna that impressed House of Flags was its white ink channels. "With a lot of alternative machines, you need to flush through the white ink channels when you're not using them," Adam explains. "It can be a long and messy process. With the Agfa printer they've literally got it down to a switch and button. They've taken away a very messy job and you just don't find that on more ordinary machines."



At this moment I'm printing tables for a hotel, which we would never have done in-house before. We can probably bring in another 50 percent of the work that we would normally send out, which is really great."

Although a further equipment purchase isn't currently on the horizon for Treacle Factory according to Jeremy, if and when the need arises, he knows who they will turn to first. "If we ever need to upgrade or if one of our machines becomes outdated, we will definitely be coming to Josero again," Jeremy concludes.

An A to Z of built-up lettering options

Through its dedicated Smith Manufacturing Division, William Smith Group 1832 provides a wide range of built-up letters to meet every conceivable sign and display requirement. The letters are manufactured in-house, primarily in aluminium but also supplied, as required, in stainless steel, using a combination of traditional skills and modern automated technologies.

Chris Bradley, Head of Marketing at William Smith Group, says, "The wide range of built-up lettering options include the non-illuminated Classic 3D, Rim and Return and Halo-illuminated models, all of which can be finished in any specified RAL colour. For special sign applications such as those found at fairgrounds, cabochon LED-illuminated built-up lettering is also manufactured, with the LED-empowered bulbs providing the required distinctive appearance."

He continues, "At Smith, a purpose-built workshop has been set up to enable all of the necessary processes required for the production of built-up letters to be carried out in-house, thereby eliminating many of the variables associated with third-party outsourcing. Production of the letters commences with cutting out the face of the letters. For this process, three different-sized AXYZ CNC routers have been installed, one of which provides an image-mapping capability, with a second incorporating a seven-station ATC (Automatic Tool Change) system for work requiring multiple tools. An Accubend channel letter bending machine has also been installed to shape the aluminium coil for the letters, prior to welding the two together. To meet different built-up lettering requirements, the coil used is in a standard thickness of 1.2mm and in six widths ranging from 35 up to 150mm."

A dedicated welding room houses several workstations incorporating MIG welders and a fume extractor. There is also a DA disc sanding facility that enables fabricators to sand down the letters and remove any contaminants prior to engaging the powder coating process. This is carried out by use of a full-size spray booth working in tandem with a batch curing oven. Currently, around 150 RAL colours are available, with any additional special colours sourced to meet a specific sign or display requirement.

"Completion of the built-up letters is carried out by fabricators fitting the different extrusions, LED illumination modules supplied by FirstLite as appropriate, locators and acrylic faces if specified, before mounting onto a Foamex carrier," explains Bradley.

Recent signage projects in which built-up letters supplied by Smith have proved pivotal to their success include those recently installed by GRS Signs, HG Graphics and Parc Signs. The GRS Signs project involved the rebranding of a major retailer for which cabochon built-up letters with integrated LED bulbs were required to make the signs synonymous with those found at fairgrounds as specified by the customer.

The HG Graphics project involved the construction of a corporate ID sign that had to be readily visible due to the client's premises being situated next to a busy bypass.

For the Parc Signs retail signage project, face- and back-illuminated built-up letters with a halo effect were required. As specified by the client, each letter had to be in a different bespoke colour to achieve the desired visual effect.

As the first phase of the manufacturing process, CNC routing and cutting are central to the success of any built-up lettering application. For a number of years, Telford, Shropshire-based AAG has been a preferred suppliers of routing/ cutting systems to the sign and display industry via its primary AXYZ power brand.

"As part of a significant investment programme in capital equipment, the UK's acknowledged leading trade-only supplier William Smith now has three AXYZ machines installed in its dedicated Sign & Display Division. The machines are used for a wide range of sign and display production requirements involving an equally diverse range of materials, with aluminium sheet, acrylic and plastics and, as required, stainless steel used in the manufacture of sign trays and associated built-up sign lettering.

Lettering and sign trays are a business must

Signscape and Signconex have been an industry leader in the sign trade since 1973. West says that lettering is a complex signage product with varying factors such as font type, depth, optional illumination and because of the added consideration of a detailed install, a skilled approach should be taken. "Lettering is most commonly supplied in aluminium, acrylic, or composite board as flat cut, built up (3D) or LED block letters. The retail sector understands letter sign requirements better than most. With customers needing to read signage instantly in our fastpaced environment, it is essential to place yourself in your clients' shoes: Are they driving by your sign in their cars, walking past them, or encountering them in-store? Senior citizens or people with vision issues call for bigger fonts, also. Keeping this in mind can enable you to create the most legible and attractive sign."

Another factor to consider when choosing fonts is the clarity of the text. Reaching prospective clients or highlighting your brand should be done with visibility in mind. Cursive and italic fonts can work but should be checked from different angles, as well as different distances before production to ensure your customer experiences a clear and on-brand effect. Always ensure people can actually read the name of your business.

Remember that when it comes to creating the best signs, sometimes less is more. A simpler, branded design isn't only more legible, it also suggests that your company



already has a strong reputation, and that your name and logo are enough to let people know they've come to the right place. Aim to design signage that captures attention, not cause distraction. Similarly, smaller signs belong where the viewer can get close to it, such as near the entrance to your business and larger signs will attract the eyes of more people because they're more visible from further away, including on busy streets, in open areas such as city centres, or higher up on taller buildings.

When planning for your new sign, take a moment to really look at it and see if there is anything that doesn't seem right. The editing stage is a good time to see if the spacing works between the letters and other elements. Assuming the ratios stay the same when enlarged to a larger size, it will look the same in its final stage. Using a mixture of small, medium, and large signs is a good way to attract customers and diversify your marketing strategy.

West says, "Nothing creates 'WOW' quite like dimension! We love to use laser cut acrylic letters to add dimension to signs and displays. If you're looking for a costeffective, yet bold and beautiful way to display your logo, mission statement or company slogan, you should consider dimensional acrylic letters. Lettering comes in either flat cut or built up (3D) letters, and LED block lettering which is a hybrid of the two."

Types of lettering

Flat cut lettering is exactly as it sounds, where lettering is cut out of a sheet of material. These are great for wall mounting and ideal for a modest budget. They can also be added to a totem or folded tray for added depth and dimension. Suitable for internal and external uses. They are typically made at a height of 1-2m and the thickness is recommended at 10% of the chosen height.

Channel letter signs are usually the signs seen on the store front of a building typically above the entrance. You may have often heard them referred to as 'Neon Signs' or even 'LED Signs, which comes from the fact that they are internally illuminated by one of these two lighting options. Channel letter signs are a bold and vibrant colour meant to attract the attention of the customers passing by especially when it is illuminated at night. They are particularly helpful during winter when the nights are long and business hours run into the night. Furthermore, they are designed in a manner that looks elegant and creative during the day too.



Letters to suit all styles and budgets

Built-up lettering is quite an art and, more often than not, hand-formed. Built up letters offer striking displays of 3D letters, with tailored features, coming with or without illumination. They have become an industry standard and a customer favourite. Great for representing your business logo on a shopfront. Dimensional acrylic letters bring impact and beauty to a variety of displays and signs. If you have a wall that needs decoration, you should consider incorporating acrylic letters.

LED block lettering is a combination of flat cut and built-up lettering made from opal acrylic, offering a slimline premium look for 3D illuminated custom sign letters which makes your brand appear as sleek and prestigious as possible, producing stunning edge-to-edge illumination.

Letter sian lighting is another element which adds custom design and functionality to your sign. It can be constructed in different ways such as standard lit through, halo lighting, and exposed lighting. The standard lit through is a dimensional letter that has lighting inside the letter with a translucent face so that the light can shine through. The halo lighting is similarly constructed except that the back of the letter is exposed, with the lighting directed towards the back so it shines around the letter giving it a halo glow. And the exposed neon is like the standard lit through lettering, except there is no face covering the letter so that the neon can directly be seen.

Fixing is also important

Fixing methods are as varied as the letters themselves. Sign letters can be mounted onto a folded aluminium tray enhancing the overall look of your lettering and making it stand out. Letters can also get fixed standing off the wall or tray using spacers which gives the illusion of the letters floating. Couple this with halo illumination and you have a visually stunning sign, especially when viewed at night.

You can manufacture lettering in pretty much any material, though some are better suited than others. Stainless steel is the most popular given its resilience to the elements and general clean appearance, even after years of exposure to all manner of conditions. Three popular finishes include brushed, mirror or powder coated but you can also use a specialist finish, such as titanium.

Acrylic has been used in letter making for years and still remains popular, adorning the walls and facades of many prominent brands along the high street. This material is available in a vast number of colours, thicknesses and finishes, some premium products have the ability to change from black to white when illuminated from the rear. The material is durable, lightweight, and easy to cut with detail and precision. It can be engraved, polished and bevel edged or add LED backlighting, the possibilities are endless! Acrylic letters and brand marks look great in lobbies or entryways. They can be used for interior or exterior signage.

Aluminium composite material (ACM) is available in many colours including

brushed silver, to emulate the appearance of stainless steel. Foamex can be cut from many different thicknesses, 3mm-20mm, should you be looking for a budget friendly letter with some real depth. As with ACM, Foamex is available in a range of different colours and can be painted to allow for exterior use. The above highlight some of the preferred lettering materials, more options include brass, copper, bronze and many more.

West adds, "Choosing a letter sign is a major brand decision and will reflect well upon your company. Signs truly have the potential to be your very own landmark."

Trays add versatility

Spencer West explains, "Folded tray signs on the other hand can be as simple or as complicated as you want them to be. Simply powder-coated with applied vinyl text or fret cut and back illuminated. Folded trays can be used as a carrier panel for built-up lettering. Trays can also be any number of different shapes for additional visual impact. Sign Trays

Important promotional sign opportunities for any business

Sign trays are essentially a blank canvas and a great starting point for any project. Aluminium, stainless steel or aluminium composite are the primary products utilised for this form of signage. SignFab (UK) Ltd creates sign tray styles according to design specification. The largest tray they can make from aluminium, in one section is 4m x 2m. However, there are challenges when going to something of this size, such as transport and more importantly, how you handle it, how many installers required?!

Julie Brett, Sales Manager of SignFab, says, "The other common myth that appears repeatedly is 'I want a standard sign tray'. There are assumptions that as an industry, we appear to think that 50mm depth is 'standard'. "30mm may suit one client and another needs 150mm, there is no right or wrong so we must look at each application on a case-by-case basis."

She continues, "Unless the positioning of the project is explained, we would use 2mm aluminium up to 1100mm in height and above that, 3mm utilised. This is subject to client's requirements as some simply prefer to use 2mm or 3mm throughout on a project."

Variety of design

SignFab offers a variety of design options to enhance the sign tray. Brett explains, "They do not need to be basic and traditional. Dependent on budget, the opportunities are endless. A traditional manufactured tray can be powder-coated or vinyl-wrapped to suit the brand and accessorised in a variety of ways to create striking signage and customised further with the addition of built-up letters, flat cut letters, vinyl letters and logos."

One of the most common ways when designing a tray is to simply make it in a single piece. If the overall length is more than the 4m standard panel length, then it will need to be in a minimum of two pieces. As part of the Signage Bootcamp run by Make it Happen Signage Consultancy, they teach the industry candidates to look at different ways of breaking down a fascia sign, for example, making the tray in three tray sections and making a feature.

Sam Armstrong, Managing Director from Make It Happen adds, "We show and advise how to make the centre panel with the logo the most prominent feature at 100mm depth. Then making the two end panels either shallower, a different colour or something that differentiates to make their clients branding the primary focus rather than having a noticeable join line down the middle."

She adds, "While the installer might prefer 2 sections, it is the client's sign, not the installer's headache. For any sign company this is a perfect opportunity for an upsell and to stand out from your competitors, as it simply isn't thought of."



A traditional manufactured tray can be customised even further with the addition of built-up letters, flat cut letters and vinyl letters and logos.

Sam Armstrong concludes, "MIH encourages the industry to ask itself 'do we really know what a sign needs to do for our client? How can I stand out from the crowd'. We have the products, technology and the will to support our customers to push the boundaries of what they can normally achieve to really meet the needs of the end users."

"Sign trays are so versatile they're what we call 'bread-and-butter' signage at Sign Supplier," says Andy Barker, Sales Director, of Sign Supplier, a full-service signage business that covers design, manufacturing and installation. He adds, "Their versatility coupled with their big impact and cost-effectiveness means that many of our customers opt for sign trays."

Custom made flat and projecting sign trays are a familiar sight on our highstreets, our industrial estates and our shopping centres. The manufacturing technique to create these types of signs hasn't changed for a long time. Metal sheets are cut or bent into shape to the required size. "Even these stalwarts of the signage world aren't immune to innovation and change and we're seeing more customer appetite for sign trays that push signage boundaries and pack more of a stylistic punch," says Barker.

Illumination

Barker explains, "The first innovation that customers leapt upon was the introduction of illuminated sign tray options. Because the body of the sign tray allows for all the wires to be hidden, customers who were put off illuminated signs by the idea of visible wires loved the clean illuminated effect that sign trays afforded them. We now see lots more businesses choosing to go illuminated and take their sign visibility 24/7."

But the biggest innovation for sign trays by far has been the advances in the finishes that can be applied to the trays. "Our stunning liquid metal paint finishes come in a choice of 16 standard metal finishes (tailor-made finishes are also available) and elevate signage to the next level. Made using 98% metal and 2% application aid, our paint finishes behave just like metal and can be polished or aging effects like patina or rust can be added. If the tray sign is completely sealed after painting and no additional ingress holes are made, this type of finish can last up to 25 years," he says.

Aluminium composite board (ACM) sign trays offer a cheaper and lighter option for those with smaller budgets or frontage that can't handle the traditional aluminium option which is both heavier and more expensive (but more hardwearing). ACM has also seen innovation in finishing options with digital print wraps now available which can transform ACM signs with wood or textured effects – anything the customer requests is possible!



This 'tray sign' mounted on posts is a little different. It was created from 2mm thick aluminium with returns soldered onto the edges just like a built up letter.

Andy Barker concludes, "The popularity of sign trays lies in the fact that there is a sign tray for every budget, location, and type of business - from storefronts, to industrial units, to outdoor commercial signage. Our design and installation team are yet to be faced with a frontage that they couldn't create a tray sign for with challenges overcome by creating bespoke shaped signs trays, or sign trays that are post or building mounted. The average starting price point for a 4-meter non-illuminated sign tray (the width of the average shopfront) is a very competitive £400, an illuminated aluminium tray sign of the same dimensions would start at £2000. And if your customers want their tray sign covered in gold paint or wrapped in leopard print, technology is on your side!"

Sign Trays

Selecting the best materials and tools for your sign trays

Sign trays are one of the most popular signs that a sign maker will cut on their machine. The choice of material type and thickness available has developed and, therefore, demand to make signs out of more difficult materials is on the rise. The traditional aluminium composite material or ACM can come in a variety of colours, thicknesses and skin thickness, but what other materials can be routed in the same way to make a traditional sign tray?

Liam Hodson, Tooling and Machining Consultant for LKH Tools, explains, "SCM or steel composite material can also be used on a router with the correct tooling. This offers a stronger, if not heavier product for certain applications. Typically, this replaces the aluminium with a steel skin each side and retains the same type of plastic core."

Fire resistant, non-combustible ACM (such as FR, A2/mineral core) is also a popular choice for certain applications which must meet stringent health and safety requirements. The core of this type of material is incredibly abrasive to standard carbide tooling due to its fire resistant properties. It generally has a slightly thicker aluminium skin top and bottom to standard ACM.

Solid aluminium is also specified for certain projects where additional strength and durability are required.

Hodson adds, "As demand increases for these materials, the tooling also has to be

available to process it. These materials are finding their way into more and more sign applications, so what is needed to process them? The Crown Norge range of tooling, has been successfully developed to process these materials for many years."

He continues, "It is easy to assume that all types of sign trays will need the same geometry of tooling when folding these materials by hand. The choice of colour, brand and thickness can make the folding process react very differently. When folding any material, the outer skin is stretched when the material is bent. This could cause cracking or discoloration of the material if the geometry of the tool cutting the groove is not correct for the application.'

Some tooling can also cause issues with the material not folding exactly in the centre, making the folding process very difficult to achieve an accurate tray which lines up with the returns. This is often evident when a tool with up to 3mm flat bottom is used. The material could fold anywhere between the 3mm slot and the inaccuracies that this creates could leave gaps in the tray when assembled as the ends would not line up.

"Thankfully, the range of folding tools from Crown Norge, offer either a combination of radius or smaller flat for precision folding," says Hodson, adding, "The V shaped tools come with either a smaller flat bottom (1.8mm) or a radius in order for the bend to be folded accurately. This ensures the material will fold at the weakest point (which would be the centre of the cut) giving a far better and more accurate assembly of the finished tray. The angle is also slightly bigger at 92 degrees to allow for the bend over and snap back that happens when folding the material by hand to 90 degrees. Other angles are also available which include 120 degree and 135 degree folds."

He continues, "In addition to the V

shaped tools, a Ball nose tool will give a much more accurate fold at the expense of more material being removed. The folded edge is also very crisp, which is favoured in some applications. Again, the material folds in the centre of the cut allowing for very accurate ACM trays to be made. These tools are also deployed when the material shifts from ACM to solid aluminium, allowing the customer to dry rout the aluminium and fold just in the same way as standard ACM."

With the introduction of tougher noncombustible A2, FR and mineral core ACM, the tooling switches to a PCD diamond tool which allows for greater tool longevity. The matching geometries in PCD allow for much higher meterage of cut per tool. 6,000 metres of linear cut is not uncommon for these tools in these demanding materials, whereas a standard uncoated carbide tool would only achieve a few metres of cut.

"In addition to the folding tools available, the Crown Norge range of cut out tools also match the extreme productivity of the folding tools. These are available in multiple sizes which includes coated and PCD tools. For standard ACM, the DLC or Superior coated tools produce an exceptionally clean cut, with a polished core and mirror finish on the aluminium. These tools can also be used in dry routing aluminium, SCM and FR core ACM at high speed which makes them incredibly versatile for the user," says Hodson.

The A2 and mineral core materials can easily be processed at a similar cutting speed to ACM thanks to the PCD range



Crown Norge tooling, has been successfully developing materials like this aluminium composite for many years

of tooling. These tools offer exceptional longevity thanks to their density and sharpness of the tool.

"In addition to the range of tools for the advanced materials, the range of acrylic and plastics tools from Crown Norge has also been bolstered to include the New GEN2 acrylic tool. This allows for a polished edge on clear acrylic, up to 20mm thick. This new addition further improves the options available to the sign maker, allowing for letters to be cut without further polishing. This is perfect for illuminated sign tray applications where the light is projected from the side of the letter," he explains.

Liam Hodson concludes, "As with all tools from Crown Norge, the exceptional quality and consistency has been tested across the UK and Europe to ensure that each tool performs correctly in each material type. The advanced tooling range from Crown Norge is available from LKH Tools in the UK."


