





AAG makes metal work better with latest purpose-built CNC router

In keeping with its known predilection for supplying purpose-built and industryspecific CNC machining solutions, AAG has now added the latest AXYZ METALWORKER routing/cutting system to its burgeoning range of bespoke machine options. From the ground up, the METALWORKER has been designed to process small- to high-volume sheets of non-ferrous metals, aluminium, metal and aluminium composites (MCM/ACM) and alloys such as copper, zinc, brass and bronze using a range of special-purpose production tools.

The METALWORER is available in a choice of nine different-sized models, the most popular of which include the 1.5 x 3m and 2.1 x 3m models, with other sizes available if required. The machines are powered by AAG's proprietary MOVE machine control software via a 22-inch multi-functional touchscreen control panel.

In addition to the now familiar single-piece solid steel frame construction designed to withstand the most vigorous machine operation likely to be encountered, coupled with a stress-relieved gantry to minimise vibration, standard design features of the AXYZ METALWORKER include direct-to-drive servomotors with built-in encoders, an aluminium T-Slot zoned vacuum deck for maximum



material hold-down efficiency, a special tool length sensor to ensure consistent routed/cut depths and the latest AXYZ helical rack and pinion drive system. This latter feature incorporates a multi gear teeth configuration that helps spread the workload more evenly, leading to faster throughput speeds (up to 35m/ min), radically reduced machine wear and material wastage and ultimately a longer than normal machine life.

These features are supplemented with other optional machine enhancements that include a variable-station ATC (Automatic Tool Change) system and a choice of five, 10 and 15hp routing spindles and ISO30 and HSK-type tool holders.

Viking UK distribution deal with Enimac for adhesive tape application machinery

The sign and point of sale industry has been identified as a keynote target market by tapes, adhesives and sealants distribution specialist, Viking Industrial, as it seals a UK-wide distribution partnership with Italian-based Enimac to market and sell its five-strong stable of adhesive tape application machines.

Viking has created an in-house demonstration suite at its headquarters in Keighley, West Yorkshire, to showcase the Enimac range to potential clients across a multi-application end-user market.

In what represents a £50k investment, the company has installed two tape application units – the XT Light 700 and XT Light 1000 - which are being used to demonstrate the latest technology for applying multiple strips of tape at up to 50 metres a minute on flat surfaces such as paper, cardboard, plastic and metal.

The machines also have the ability to apply tape to correx, foamex, acrylic sheet, plastic extrusion and aluminium composite - and can also be adopted to apply magnetic strip.

Viking's sales and marketing director Colin Bennett regards the deal with Enimac, based just outside Milan and part of Biemme Adesivi, as a major coup. Both firms are premier tape distributors for 3M, with Viking remaining the global technology giant's leading online partner in the UK.

He explained: "We clinched the deal with Enimac because of our industry knowledge, our web presence and our long-time partnership with 3M. We are both family-run companies, with over 80 years' combined experience in our specialist sectors and a joint goal of achieving tape application automation.

"The Enimac range of adhesive tape application machines is both versatile and flexible, offering speed and precision accuracy to improve productivity, to cut and apply all types of adhesive tape via touchscreen inputs.

"Specialist features include the ability to accommodate the largest formats of offset printing and many formats of digital printing and up to six independently programmable patented "paste and cut" applicators.

"The machines require limited space, are fully mobile, operate using standard

electric and, unlike some others, do not require compressed air, so reducing maintenance costs. The current 130% super deduction on capital expenditure until 2023 also comes into the equation.

"We feel confident the range will appeal to the sign and point of sale industry in what is essentially an emerging market in the UK. Early interest from potential customers via our website is encouraging."

The Viking range of long length doublesided tapes for the Enimac machines come in 500m, 600m, 1000m, up to 6000m lengths, with either standard or oversize liners for easy removal included in the packages.

Colin explained: "A key component is the latest 3M "Go To" tape GPT 020 - the next generation of thin bonding tapes, offering greater design possibilities, with a high grab long lasting acrylic adhesive that will stick to most High and Low Surface energy materials without the need for special primers. 3M have now added 3800 and 5000 metre rolls ideally suited to the versatility of the Enimac machines, with speeds of up to 50m per minute."

Viking has been supplying a range of products to the sign Industry since its formation over 30 years ago and throughout this time has been a main distributor for 3M. It also offers an in-house tape slitting facility, again well utilised by the sign and point of sale sector.

Chemical Etching

What can you do with Chemical Etching?

Chemical etching is a process that has been used to create decorative images into metals for thousands of years. It is also known as chemical engraving, because just like engraving, it creates recesses in the metal, but with much finer detail, and for sign making it has many advantages over mechanical engraving. If you have a lot of detail to engrave, it is a lot quicker, and therefore cheaper than mechanical engraving, and leaves a smooth and attractive surface with no unsightly machining marks.

The three principal uses for chemical etching in the sign industry are for higher quality wayfinding signage, such as in apartment complexes or hotels, business nameplates such as the traditional brass plates often seen at the entrance to solicitors, dentists and accountants, and for commemorative plaques for opening ceremonies and bench memorials. Chemical etching also makes high quality labels, which is something often forgotten by sign-makers, which are used for everything from point of sale display to engineering nameplates. These are after all just miniature signs.

Colin Edge, Managing Director of Multitechnic, based in Northumberland, explains, "Most sign companies sub-contract their chemical etching requirements to specialists, for a lot of very good reasons. It requires a lot of specialist equipment, and unless you want acidic vapours destroying the rest of your equipment, it needs to be in a dedicated wet room with good ventilation. Chemical

etching just creates the images in the metal, nothing more than empty holes, so you also need specialist skills to fill those holes with paint. If you don't do it the right way, that paint is going to come back out again pretty soon."

He adds, "The chemistry of the etching process isn't as simple as you might think, and if you start to etch a mixture of brass and stainless steel, you will soon find yourself in all sorts of trouble. You also have to consider storage and disposal of quite large volumes of acidic liquid, and if you start washing acidic rinse water down the drain, you might get a visit from a man in a suit asking some very awkward questions."

Just because you leave chemical etching to specialists does not mean that you shouldn't get to know how it all works. According to Edge, it is actually quite simple. "All chemical etching does is make holes in the surface of the metal. The surface is either etched or it isn't, so any image that works in black and white can be etched. This even includes photographs, because you can reproduce photographic images from lots of tiny dots. Once you have made the holes in the metal, you usually then fill them with paint, which can be any colour. Creating complex designs in lots of colours is perfectly feasible, and you can even have colours fading into each other."


He continues, "At Multitechnic Ltd, we are celebrating our 50th anniversary this year. There is nothing about etching of

signs that we don't know. If you want an easy to read summary of all you need to know about chemical etching, just have a look at the guide on our website https://multitechnic.co.uk/services/chemicaletching and in less time than it takes to drink your morning cup of coffee you will be as much of an expert as you need to be."

Colin Edge answers key questions for chemical etching

How deep can you etch? This depends on how fine the detail is. When you etch into metals, the image etches sideways as well as down, so the deeper you etch, the less crisp the image is. Multitechnic have special etching machines made to their own designs, which gently wash the etched panels in a fine mist and can achieve incredible detail. Most designs work best at a depth of around 0.1mm, which doesn't sound a lot, but gives by far the most pleasing appearance. Etching deeper doesn't achieve anything, and for most designs doesn't look as nice. The other extreme is deep embossed signs, and Multitechnic have a specially developed process that can etch to 1mm deep or more, and brass rubbing plates can be etched this way while retaining fine detail. Bear in mind that deep etching creates a dirt trap that is difficult to clean, so for choosing the right depth, it is best to leave it to the experts.

What metals can you etch? By far the most popular metal for etched signs is stainless steel, then brass, but it is also

possible to etch other copper alloys such as bronze, or even copper itself. Some of the coloured stainless steels from Rimex will etch, some won't, so check with the experts before you go designing anything exotic, and they will advise which colours can be used. Aluminium does not etch well enough for signage. It just doesn't look nice, and that really is all you need to know as far as signage is concerned.

of coloured signage, not just etching or engraving. CMYK is fine for digital print, but not for paint. HEX & RGB are for television & monitor screens, and depending on how your customer's screen is adjusted, you could end up with a colour that is far from what your customer imagines it should be. For these colours it is always worth printing what you think the colour should be on your own printer, get

your customer to approve it, then match it to the closest Pantone, BS or RAL.

Colin Edge concludes, "The main point to remember about chemically etched signage is when to use it, and when not to. If your customer wants some stylish stainless steel wayfinding signage for upmarket apartments, then etched stainless steel will work superbly and your customer will be delighted. If they want some swimming pool signage and insist that it must be etched stainless steel, explain that the paint won't last long with chlorinated condensation on it all day and night, and if they still won't take no for an answer, just make sure you cover yourself so there is no comeback when it all inevitably goes horribly wrong. Brass signage for a hotel is exactly what chemical etching is there for, but a large safety sign in a playground is unlikely to be a sensible choice. As for any other specialist sign product, if in doubt, ask the experts. They will always be happy to talk, and if they aren't, then maybe you are talking to the wrong experts."



Can you put etched marine grade stainless steel by the sea front? In a word, no. The stainless steel will be fine, and Multitechnic only use 316 marine grade stainless steel. The etched stainless steel may be fine, but no paint survives long in a marine environment, certainly not the sorts of paints that can be used to fill etchings or engravings, and the signs are useless without paint. For signs by the sea, on the decks of ships, and also for swimming pool and sauna signage, Multitechnic have developed their digital anoprinting to create signage solutions for these difficult environments.

Can you match specific colours? Pretty much anything RAL, BS or Pantone can be matched, even many of the metallics. If your customer specifies HEX, RGB or CMYK colours, you might end up in trouble, and this applies to all sorts


Photocast Products Ltd started life in 1988 from the corner of a rented warehouse with a small zinc etching plant and an assortment of bench tools, and a small paint booth. According to the company's Director, Pauline Hill, the main style of business at this time was the production of machine ID/nameplates and labels as well as small painted plaques. "Whilst we still have a large involvement with these items it was the development and our involvement with the zinc photoengraving process that has enabled us to produce deep etched plates while retaining highly accurate detail that has escalated our business and continues to dazzle."

There is a phrase often used in photoengraving 'if you can draw it, we can etch it'. That certainly rings true with all the plaques and panels produced at Photocast, which is all achievable thanks to their highly skilled in-house team of image manipulation artists.

Pauline explains, "Our business growth was dependent on the size and scale of our etched plate production and all of the associated techniques. Investment in three 210 litre etch baths, large format paint and finishing equipment, together with embracing all of the latest artwork and film production hardware and software enabled us to produce ever larger and more detailed plaques and panels.

Colour provides a great effect

To facilitate all these developments, Photocast also had to move to new purpose built 6500 sq. ft. premises. "This move has allowed us to have continued developing our etching and finishing techniques and broaden our product range. This has led inevitably to an increased and more varied customer base," she says.

Pauline continues, "From our original plaques and labels work we moved into golf signage and large interpretive panels, blue plaque schemes, personal and memorial plaques and dedications as well as a newly created product range of donor or dedication walls and panels."

Magnesium etching

Photocast also invested in a new Magnesium etching plant. This enables the company to deep etch tooling plates for several interesting industries. "We use deep etched magnesium plates for detailed casting patterns that we send to our foundry for traditional sand casting. We then finish the castings on site in Liverpool. We also moved into the printing

world and created a new company call 'The Blockshop', which uses all our inhouse capabilities to produce letterpress printing plates, hot foil stamping blocks and embossing and debossing stamping tools. This is a great addition to our product range and a stand-out company in a shrinking market," says Pol.

Acquisition leads to greater capabilities

Further developments for Photocast were made in March 2020 when long time business friends Charles H Coward Ltd of Sheffield acquired Photocast. CHC Group Sales Director Chris Hogan explains, "We had worked with Photocast for the production of their bronze and aluminium sand casting of plaques for over eight years and when the opportunity came up to take over the ownership of the business and offer all of our full capacities and experience in metal technologies seemed the right thing to do. It was immediately clear to all involved at Photocast that we had squared the circle to become, perhaps, the only group that now has

the skills to create cast products from conception to completion."

Hogan continues, "With adding our foundry facilities to the Photocast armoury

we can also push the casting boundaries even further. After much development work we now have the ability to combine etched patterns with CNC sections to create a range of bas relief plaques, which enabled Photocast to compete with the much more labour intense and costly fine arts casting."

Photocast's customer base continues to grow from individuals and small sign outlets to some of the largest organisations in the UK and Europe. "We have been involved in projects for The National Trust, English Heritage, The British Legion, The War Graves Commission, The Plymouth Mayflower 400 year project along with Liverpool and Arsenal Football Clubs," he says.

Chris Hogan concludes, "As our technical skills evolve, we are always looking to develop new and innovative products as well as working alongside our customers and partners to achieve attractive, practical and fine art pieces."

Chemical etching is a complex multistage process requiring a range of equipment, skilled labour and space. For many sign companies it is not convenient or cost effective to set up in-house. TED allows sign companies to offer a broad range of chemical etched products to their customers, without the large upfront cost of setting up an in-house etching department and the steep learning curve

that comes with mastering the process. In a nutshell the chemical etching process involves thoroughly cleaning the metal prior to laminating with a UV sensitive film resist

A photo tool of the desired artwork is printed on clear film and placed on the material before being exposed under UV light. The UV light passes through the clear areas of the photo tool hardening the laminated film. The sheet is then chemically developed to wash away the unexposed portions, leaving behind a very precise mask of hardened photoresist. The material is then placed in a conveyorised spray etching machine.

High temperature acid is sprayed at high pressure onto the surface and etches the areas left unprotected by the photoresist to create the desired image. Depth of etch is controlled by the speed of the conveyor. After etching, the photoresist is stripped in a heated bath and the material is then ready for any post etching processes that may be required such as colour infilling, patination, bending or forming.

Versatile and comprehensive for multiple applications

"We are able to etch a wide variety of metals including Stainless Steel, Brass, Copper, Bronze, Zinc, Aluminium and more. A typical working week can see us etch everything from patinated brass signage for a high end hotel development to

Bath-based branding and signage business Freestyle Designs has been established for 14 years, specialising in a range of services from standard shop signage projects to large rebrands, vehicle graphics, wallcoverings and vinyl graphics, and more. Founder and Managing Director Jayson Godridge loves to keep the business moving forward, whether that's staying up-to-date with the latest technology and investing in new kit, or targeting larger scale, higher volume work. "We knew we weren't going to be able to achieve that with our current machinery," explains Jayson.

The search was on for the right piece of equipment to help Freestyle eliminate bottlenecks and pursue those higher volume projects. They were after something faster, higher quality, with increased output. With a machine size and a couple of manufacturers in mind, after a special summer event at the Agfa showroom in Rugby, Jayson soon ended up setting his sights on a larger model – the Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED.

"It was bigger than the machines we were originally looking at," says Jayson, "but when I went to see it in action at Agfa it was clear that it would fit just fine, and that it was definitely the machine that would help us grow and push into different areas and different types of work. As soon as I walked in and saw it printing, I knew I wanted to go for it!"

Jayson is satisfied that support from Josero doesn't end there: "When we wanted a bit more training they were happy to come and help, bringing support from Agfa with them as well. It's quite a lot to learn when you get a new machine and the RIP is different and everything, but Josero are just at the other end of the phone whenever we needed them, and always very helpful."

The machine is already earning its keep and helping Freestyle meet its goals, as Jayson says: "The bottleneck doesn't exist at all anymore. The machine is a beast, and is just churning through the work. It's very reliable and working really well." The work going through the Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED includes exhibition graphics, display boards and POS projects, and it's helping Freestyle to promote their ecofriendly range of products as well.

New possibilities are also opening up to Freestyle thanks to the Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED, as Jayson explains: "We're using different media, and we're able to work with wider media because it's a

hybrid machine. We can print rolls, which we couldn't do before on our flatbed, so we're now printing rolls up to 2.5 metres wide which has massively increased our output."

There are also other new opportunities brought about by the new kit that have pleasantly surprised Jayson and the Freestyle team, as detailed by Jayson: "We've been approached by other sign companies that have heard we have the machine, and we've been producing work for them when they're over capacity themselves, so we're seeing unexpected advantages. I really wasn't expecting trade work to be coming off the back of this new machine, especially so quickly. We've done a few decent sized jobs from it, and those companies were really impressed by how quickly we could turn it around."

For Jayson Godridge and the Freestyle Designs team, the investment in the Agfa Anapurna H2500i LED from Josero has exceeded expectations by delivering on their original requirements and delivering unanticipated business benefits as well. Would Jayson work with Josero again for any future equipment needs? "Definitely," he says. "I'd be happy to work with Josero again – they've been so easy to deal with."





Lamination

Which laminator is right for your business?

Matt Manteit, International Sales Manager at Neschen Coating GmbH, outlines how to ensure you are investing in the right laminator, highlighting the most important factors to consider.

What to focus on:

Rollers

The Rollers are the most important part of a laminator; their properties and behaviour have a crucial influence on the operator's efficiency and the quality of the final product.

First off, make sure you check the diameter. As a general rule, bigger is better, as rollers with a bigger diameter tend to bend less, provide equal pressure and during operation apply less tension on the laminating film, which is beneficial when working with cast vinyls or standard laminating films.

A laminator with a bigger roller diameter has a positive impact on the possible amount of shrinkage of the over-stretched laminating film at the latter stage. Shrinkage, caused by over-stretching during the laminating process, usually leads to bleed at the end of a graphic, as well as bending of the laminated boards, lifting corners and edges of the graphic or lifting the graphic from the corrugation.

In addition, a roller with a bigger diameter is better when it comes to laminating onto soft substrates. A bigger roller distributes pressure equally and over a wider area and, therefore, the substrates have less of

a tendency to twist.

When considering the roller parameters, also check the thickness of the material. Thicker metal will provide much better stability than thinner steel, even with the same roller diameter. For this reason, stronger and more stable rollers are important for laminating onto harder substrates like MDF and glass.

Another useful parameter to check is the weight of the roller. Good and reliable rollers have a weight of approximately 40kg, meaning two rollers in the machine will weigh about 80kg in total. So, when you see a laminator datasheet and the total weight of the machine is 150kg including the frame, you know what to expect – a less than robust machine.

The last part of the roller you should focus on is the soft coating. This should be thick enough to resist possible grinding of the coating in the future, while the rubber coating should also provide perfect geometry, ideally with a crown shape on one of the two rollers.

Heating

Next up, you should consider the heating of the roller. Even for pressure sensitive adhesives – or so-called cold laminating films – we suggest using a machine with a heated top roller. The temperature should be up to 70°C, with the option to make continual adjustments in small steps. Heated rollers allow the adhesive to flow and, depending on the materials being used, this can have a big influence on the

quality of the lamination results.

As heat helps the adhesive to flow, this also helps to prevent or reduce silvering. Typically, a quite difficult application is laminating onto acrylic sheets, but having heat assistance helps a lot. You will appreciate the higher temperatures above 50°C, either when running thicker laminating films or already-laminated graphics through the laminator a second time, in order to improve the silvering.

During the second run, you can afford temperatures much higher than during the first run because the material has already been laminated. Therefore, you can run the material through the machine even faster.

Pressure setup

Each material you work with needs a different pressure setup. For example, laminating cardboards will mean you will minimise the pressure, whereas for laminating thick floor graphic films, this will require as much pressure as possible

Most of the machines on the market offer manual pressure setup, which can cause many problems with pressure distribution and when laminating longer runs.

Pressure settings and the achieved work results, for most of the machines with a mechanical setup, are very inaccurate. This means that if there is a pressure measurement available, it is not always reliable.

At Neschen, our laminators offer a pneumatic pressure system, allowing for both repeatable and exact pressure adjustments. The pressure you see on the manometer display is the actual pressure the rollers are delivering to your graphic, meaning much more accurate results.

Controls and Ergonomics

The control panel on the machine should allow for rotation, changing of speed and direction of the rollers from both sides of the device. This holds especially true if only one operator works with the laminator, as the machine can be easily operated without having to walk around to the other side to reach parts of the control panel.

Coaxial and Torsional Stiffness

All of the rollers and axes have to be exactly parallel on a laminator. This, together with high torsion stiffness of the machine chassis, ensures accurate

guidance of the material, even for full roll-to-roll jobs at high speed. If you expect your next machine to run full-roll laminating jobs, make sure to test it on your new laminator before making a purchase.

When discussing chassis strength, there are numerous machines on the market – usually very low-budget machines – which will provide the necessary construction stiffness for the first few months of ownership, but in time, the chassis weakens.

It is for this reason that Neschen offers machines with a sturdy and robust construction. Keep in mind, a laminator is a tool to enhance your business' profit and it should never be an afterthought to buying a new printer.

To provide a stable, robust and reliable machine construction, Neschen builds its range of laminators with sidewalls made of heavy steel plates instead of a thin metal plate.

Unwinding and Reeling of the Material

Brakes on the unwind and wind-up shafts must be easy to access and to handle,

as well as resistant. Inserting the shafts into the machine has to be an easy and smooth process, so consider the weight of the shaft, including the full roll, and ensure that the material slides into the machine quickly.

The measuring scale on each shaft, with the "0" being in the middle of the shaft, is a very helpful tool for setting-up the media and the alignment to the windup shaft.

Ready for Testing?

Last but not least, once you are ready for the testing of your laminator, you should focus on a series of key criteria during the demonstration to ensure it matches your requirements.

First, use greyscale pictures for the test and let the operator laminate at least 20 linear metres. Ask the operator to stop the machine in the middle of the laminating process and check the line on the graphic afterwards; there should be only a light stripe visible – or better still – nothing visible. For a roll-to-roll full-length test, you can use and laminate standard coloured vinyl, ideally in black.

Next, watch the speed of alignment, accuracy and efficiency of the demonstrated machine, and also be sure to test paper together with lamination. Paper is more inclined to wave than self-adhesive vinyl and remember that this effect will disappear during the day, but some will occur within a few days later, so take your time to evaluate the laminated material

For machines with a working width in excess of 160cm, you should test laminating onto sheet material, ideally onto PVC foamed boards that are more than 800mm wide. With these formats, you will realise the advantages of a stiff crown being on the top roller as, otherwise, bubbles may occur on the board, even up to a few days after application.

Finally, you should check the safety system. Does it work properly? Are the light-bar, the snail mode and foot switch, as well as other features, working in favour of the operator? Keep in mind, the safety system is there to protect the employee and your business.

A good safety straight edge is an essential tool in any sign production environment to assist in the safe cutting of many of the materials used in the modern Signage and Graphics industry. A good quality straight

edge will have an anodised or stainless steel cutting edge to protect the tool itself from the blade cutting into it and damaging the profile. This ensures a smooth straight cut.

The Artemis safety edge is a good example of this with its curved profile to protect your hand from the cutting blade and a guaranteed accuracy of 0.4mm straightness over the length of the safety edge. The Artemis has been specially shaped to focus downward pressure and enable clamping of the work piece whilst protecting the fingers against any tool slippages. A full-length metric/imperial scale is fitted along the front edge and a press fit stainless steel bead helps to

protect the aluminium edge from blade damage. The underside features two full length silicone inserts to assist gripping and to provide essential protection for sensitive surfaces. The Artemis is available in 6 sizes: 60cm (24"), 100cm (40"), 150cm (60"), 200cm (80"), 250cm(100"), 300cm (120").

Gardener adds, "To assist in those perfectly straight cuts, Signgeer would also recommend investing in a cutting mat. Their special construction and self-healing characteristics protect your tabletop and ensure the perfect clean cut every time - a self-healing cutting mat will prevent the knife from slipping into the grooves of previous cuts. This in turn increases the life-span of your knives and blades as well as your worktop."

"Cutting knives, like a squeegee, are down to personal preference. There's the tried and tested Swann Morton and Olfa knifes and in addition to this, Signgeer offers the NT Cutter range, which includes a wide choice of quality, cost effective handles along with quality Japanese blade sharpness. NT Cutter is popular with vehicle wrappers as they offer a good choice of plastic handles (and metal too!) with smooth contours reducing the possibility of damage to vehicle paintwork as well as super sharp blades in 30 and 58 degree angles - please remember that a blunt blade can cause more damage than a sharp one!" says Gardener.

She continues, "A good all-rounder knife is the Apex cutter from Signgeer. Offering an Ergonomic handle design and accepting 30° or 58°, 9mm blades along with a shielded cutter that allows you to cut Knifeless Tapes, string, cord etc. even when the blade is retracted. Available in widths to accommodate up to 1500mm wide media this tool will allow you to tape up graphics every time with no creases, wrinkles or bubbles. The Application Tape Dispenser from Signgeer can be either screwed to the worktop or a pair of removable anchor points allow it to sit on the edge of the worktop and be easily moved when not in use."

Static which attracts dust and particles is an age-old enemy in vinyl applications. She explains, "To prevent unwanted contamination under prints and vinyl during application we would recommend a Signgeer Dust Magnet. The Dust Magnet is a tried and tested well established sign-makers' tool, which you will find will soon pay for itself by avoiding the costly and time consuming scenario of reprints due to contamination between the vinyl and board during application."

What is the best way to cut foam board?

7 Rules to choosing the best foam board cutter

Printers and sign-makers need to cut and finish foam board or Foamex quickly and cleanly. Effective foam board cutting speeds up production, reduces waste and increases profitability. Cutting your own foam board is easy and gives you control over quality, supply, and costs.

Debbie Pendergrast is Business

experience to detail the essential points
to consider when choosing your method
and machinery for cutting foam board."

Here are Keencut's essential points to successful foam board cutting:

1. Buy a versatile cutter

Invest in a cutter that cuts various materials and can cut foam board up to a thickness of 13mm. Your business requirements and opportunities may change over time, and the more versatile your cutter, the less need for repeated capital expenditure. Look for a cutter bar that will cut a range of materials such as foam board, banner materials, cardboard, plastics, fabrics, papers, films, even aluminium composite panels. Buying a cutter that can cut rigid, semi-rigid and flexible materials will increase your flexibility.

2. Cut foam board with an accurate, clean, perfect finish

Ultimately, quality counts. There is no point in creating a great signboard and trimming it badly. The quality finish of a



packed box of uniformly cut foam board signs always impresses the customer. You need a smooth, clean cut. Poor foam board cutting leaves jagged edges, dust, and debris. Make sure the quality finish is perfect irrespective of the thickness of the board. You also want a cutting process that does not leave dust and debris all over your finished boards, especially if laminating, or your workshop. Perfect finish and precision accuracy reduces waste and so increases profit.

3. Speed up production with a better foam board cutting process


Cutting and trimming foam board can be extremely time-consuming. Choosing a cutter that quickly completes the cutting process is essential, but only if it cuts accurately and cleanly. The dramatic increase in production speed offered by a quality machine comes from the material set-up and alignment speed. It is the ease of set-up that has a direct impact on productivity and so profits. It is not about slicing as fast as you can. There can be a tendency to execute the cut too quickly,

which can result in a ripping action. To cut foam board, you need a steady cutting action and for the board to remain in place. The blade will act like a wedge if you cut too quickly, leaving a rough, uneven cut. Also, remember that cold boards do not cut as well, so bring them to room temperature before cutting.

You need a machine that allows you to accurately align the material, cut perfectly and then move quickly to the next board.

4. Clamp foam board securely without damaging the surface

Your printed foam board needs to be held securely for cutting but in a way that does not damage the printed surface. You need a precision cutting machine with a clamping system that holds the board firmly without marking the surface. You also want to be able to make fine adjustments, so the clamp needs to lower and then hover just above the surface of the material before you fully engage the clamp.

5. Effortlessly cut even thick foam board

Cutting foam board is a repetitive task, so comfort and ease of cutting are vital. Even with the thicker boards of up to 13mm, you should be able to cut with minimal effort. Your cutter needs to offer a smooth passage up and down the length of the cutter bar, with zero sideways movements to ensure a perfectly straight line.

You should be able to adopt a posture that effectively uses your body weight to aid the cutting process. The cutting tool head should be comfortable in your hand for pushing and pulling actions, whether you use your left or right-hand. Look at the effort required for each cut and how the cutting head feels in your hand - remember you will be using this machine all day every day.

6. Cut foam board safely

This sounds obvious, but you need to be safe. Using a metal rule and hand knife is both risky and less accurate than using a professional cutter. Every aspect of the cutting machine should be designed to ensure your safety. Look at whether the blades automatically retract, and how easy and safe is it to change blades. Look for magnetic blade cartridges that can speed up the interchanging of blades of different depths.

7. Buy a cutter bar that will last

You need to be confident in the durability of the cutting machine you choose. This unit will become the workhorse of your workshop, and it should be built to last and remain accurate.

There are some essential features to consider. The cutting track should be heavy-duty steel, and the interchangeable tool heads must have steel bearings to maintain accuracy and ensure durability. The whole unit should be manufactured from the highest quality materials and always look for a good guarantee and a guaranteed accuracy rating.

Pendergrast adds, "Keencut has a range of machines for those working in busy production facilities or areas with occasional cutting needs. 
Perhaps a lesser-known accessory is the 5-way tool, used predominantly for window graphics and frosting installation the 5-way tool helps you trim the film neatly against the seals and reduce the classic cut wobble when trimming along borders on continuous runs. With a nice handle and multiple cutting edges, the 5-way tool guides your blade alongside the seals and keeps the material tight to the borders. A must have for any installer working with glazing and office portioning.

Emblem Removal Tool

A great little vehicle wrap preparation tool. Allowing for easy and safe removal of car badges, emblems and lettering. The emblem removal tool has two handles and a thin braided line. Used like a cheese wire, the braided filament passes behind the vehicle badge and cuts through adhesive holding the badge to the car.



Make the material magnetic with a wrap patch

Standard magnetic grippers are brilliant for holding graphics onto vehicles while positioning, however when positioning vinyl onto glazing, aluminium, plastic bumpers or fibre glass the magnets have no power to hold. In these instances, a magnetic wrap patch is just the thing you need. With nano technology the non-adhesive pad will hold onto any flat clean surface and allow your standard magnets to grip. A lifesaver when applying repeating patterns onto glazing or fleet graphics onto windows.




Precision cutting with OLFA TS1 – top sheet cutter

The OLFA TS-1 is a unique cutting knife that has an adjustable pressure tip to only cut the top layer of vinyl on the backing paper. This is a great tool for finishing small prints that require simple contour cutting without putting the graphics through the plotter. The TS-1 allows you to cut even the thinnest films without going through into the paper liner.

Mounting self-adhesive vinyl to aluminium and aluminium composite panels is best suited to nice clean edged panel cuts, unfortunately many of the cutting tools and saws can leave the edges of the panels uneven, rough or with burrs. To save filing or block sanding edges the best tool to use is a "deburrer". Low cost and yet so effective the Hilka deburrer has a swivel blade that is run along the edge of the sheet removing the nasty edge and leaving a nice, rounded corner.

Another 4,000 trees planted for the Young People's Forest

Premier and their guests once again joined forces with the Woodland Trust to create new native woodland in the Derbyshire countryside as part of the Carbon Capture® programme.

On the 25th November, Premier teamed up with some of their customers, Sylvamo, Link Publishing, the Outdoor Guide and CBBC presenter Gemma Hunt to brave the cold and plant saplings with the Woodland Trust, at the Young People's Forest in Mead, Derbyshire. Guests from around the UK, from Southampton to Glasgow, travelled to take part in the day and help with this amazing project.

Guests were welcomed with hot breakfasts, teas and coffees; and after introductions from Premier's Marketing Director, Dave Jones and the Woodland Trust's Ollie Cannon, promptly took to the fields to begin planting. The target for the day was to plant at least 3,000 trees that are native to the area including holly, silver birch, alder and oak. By the end of the day an incredible total of 4,000 indigenous saplings were planted, despite a few cold hands.

Young People's Forest Mead is located just south of Heanor and Smalley in the heart of the Derbyshire countryside, the 162-hectare site is steeped in history with ties stretching back to the Norman conquest and the Vikings, over 1,000 years ago.
