Widd Signs has invested in a second Mimaki UCJV300-160 UV LED printer from CMYUK. The installation comes 3 years after the business bought its first Mimaki printer of the same model, again from CMYUK. Offering versatile productivity, this printer offers the ability to print and cut in a single unit. Purchased to respond to growing demand, it will increase production capacity and turnaround.

"Clients are increasingly requiring a shorter turnaround on jobs and the Mimaki printer is very efficient so allows us to increase capacity to be able to accommodate a quicker lead time," says Gary Williams, MD, Widd Signs.

### Great grandfather of signage

Widd Signs was formed in 1888 by Bradford-based sign writer Arthur Widd and is regarded as one of the original sign companies in the UK. The same founding values that made it an instant success in the 19th Century runs through the business today: innovation, design, excellence, and honesty. Operating in the north of England, it now has sites in Leeds and St Helens, supported by a 70-strong team of employees.

The business provides signage consultancy, design, and production services to a range of high-profile businesses operating in the retail, construction, sports, and leisure sectors. Clients include high street retail giants Marks & Spencer, Primark and schuh; culture and leisure hubs such as the National Science and Media Museum, Chelsea and Burnley F.C; and construction firms including Winvic, ISG, Robert Mcalpine, Audas and Wates.

# Shift Graphics invest in new Mimaki equipment for faster turnaround

Solihull-based Shift Graphics has invested in a Mimaki UJV 100-160 UV LED printer and Mimaki CG-130AR cutting plotter from CMYUK. The new equipment has enabled this start-up to produce fast turnaround vinyl graphics in-house up to 1.6m wide for the exhibitions sector.

"The key issue regarding this investment was turnaround times particularly for vinyl and smaller graphics," says Shift Graphics' owner and M.D. Mike Clarke.

"I could have started my business without any production equipment, but then I'd be limiting my service offerings – becoming just another middleman. Exhibition builds can be incredibly frantic and stressful, so to be able to offer our customers that reassurance that we can and will react instantly to support them is huge and sets us apart."

#### Mimaki reassurance

Mike, former Live Events Manager at Hollywood Monster, is a seasoned graphics display professional. He decided to invest in Mimaki equipment because of the balance it offers between quality, affordability, and reliability.

The Mimaki UJV100-160 is a 1.6m wide UV LED printer that offers a resolution of up to 1200dpi. It supports a wide variety of materials including textiles, vinyl, and banner.

Its dual-layer printing feature allows white ink to be used on transparent PET film, while clear ink can be printed to achieve a topcoat varnish effect.

This is a dedicated roll-to-roll UV LED curable printer that offers high quality, stability, and productivity due to a NCU (Nozzle Check Unit), NRS (Nozzle Recovery System) and MAPS4 (Mimaki Advanced Pass System4). A new DAS (Dot Adjustment System) has automated dot position and feed correction, further reducing operator workload.

"There are not many printers about at that price point with the quality of the UJV output. It's a very easy printer to live with, simple to use, and not temperamental. All in all, it's been a very smooth journey and if I have any hiccups, CMYUK is there at the end of the phone. They are a trusted and well-respected supplier that is the natural go-to for our industry," says Mike.

He chose UV LED print technology for its instant drying abilities and quick turnaround times. "We print same day or next day. I'll get a request to print something overnight that'll be installed in an exhibition hall the next morning. Outputting UV means it's consistent with the supersized 5m work out there. There's no point me producing gloss graphics if other walls are going to be matt. It's all about uniformity," he says.

### Adding in-house cutting

Mike was outsourcing all his cutting work but decided to also invest in Mimaki's new CG-130AR cutting plotter, which he feels complements his new printer perfectly.

This entry-level cutter offers improved cutting performance and compatibility with a wide range of materials, at an affordable price point. It features a cutting area of 1,370mm (53.9inches) and a cut pressure of 550g that expands the range of cuttable materials. In addition to a new line-up option for full cardboard cutting, it's suited to sign and displays, window graphics, packaging, stickers, labels, and decals.


#### Happy first birthday

# British Fabric Printing installs Epson SureColor SC-F9400H



The Epson SureColor SC-F4900H is a fast, high volume, six-colour, 64 inch paper transfer sublimation printer, suitable for sports and fashion

British Fabric Printing (BFP) has installed an Epson SureColor SC-F9400H dye sublimation printer from CMYUK. This enables the business to expand beyond the printing of natural stretch jersey fabrics for children's clothing into producing polyester-based textiles for sportswear, athleisure and interiors.

BFP was founded in 2020 by Essex-based duo Lisa Bence and Stuart Kettridge. Lisa had set up her own online children's clothing store in 2017, where she was selling her own designs, and Stuart was working as a stone cleaner by day and an audio mastering engineer by night. The growing popularity of the digital store and Lockdown presented the couple with the opportunity to really focus on the business. The idea was to bring the necessary equipment in-house for the printing and production of Lisa's designs, and as a secondary spin-off, also offer an online bespoke printing service.

In the last 2.5 years BFP has also installed 2 X Mimaki TX300 pigment ink printers, a Klieverik VERTEX calender press, all from CMYUK. "CMYUK have helped us enormously since we began. They will always go the extra mile for us, and we trust their guidance and advice," says Stuart.

The installation of a paper transfer dye sublimation printer had been in the back of the couple's mind for some time. "Since day one, we've been badgered to print polyesters but obviously you need dye sublimation paper transfer to do that. So, while it's always been on the cards, we felt initially, we just needed to concentrate on our cotton jersey materials and products," he says.

### **Expanding horizons**

CMYUK invited the couple to its demonstration and training facility in Shrewsbury, where the Epson SureColor SC-F9400H was put through its paces. This is a fast, high-volume, six-colour, 64-inch paper transfer sublimation printer that is suitable for sports and fashion apparel, soft signage and other textile applications. It also has the ability to print fluorescent pink and yellow to create an array of dayglow spot colours, bringing impactful

designs to garments and other items where intense hues are required.

Using water-based pigmented inks, designs are printed to paper, transferred onto fabric by a calender press where heat and pressure transforms the ink into a gas. This fuses and bonds with the fibres within the textile, creating highly durable, washand rub-fast prints.

The Epson SureColor SC-F9400H has a maximum print speed of 108.6m2 per hr for fast turnarounds. Settings deliver a lower tension and accurate registration, improving take-up and reducing the total cost of ownership (TCO) by using lower-weight sublimation papers.

"It's an amazing printer. The quality, speed, colour vibrancy added to the fact that you can print dayglow pink and yellow spot colours make it really impressive. The results are fabulous. People are really excited about it. We'll be launching a new section on our website featuring these new fluorescent designs, providing a unique angle that no one else is doing. New products for adults as well as children will include swimwear, active wear, leggings and softshell raincoats. We're also going to be offering blinds, we really want to branch out and this technology is an ideal platform on which to expand," says Stuart.

#### Efficient technology

Lisa and Stuart are interested in increasing output but still keeping the business as an enterprise that is run in the main by the two of them. The sewing of the children's clothing has recently been outsourced to another home-grown British company, giving them time to design, produce and market their new product categories.

Says Stuart, "We're just getting on with the next level of our business and we're ensuring that this is something we can handle by investing in technology that gives us versatility, greater efficiency and speed so we can do more within existing time scales. Already we've seen the difference as evenings and weekends have become family time once again. We've had lots of interest already from dance schools and those wanting bespoke blinds. It's an exciting time."

# Marine Signage

# Multitechnic - catering to marine signage since 1970's



Multitechnic's Anoprinted aluminium is printed on open pore aluminium, then "sealed", creating an extremely durable print to withstand a marine environment.

#### Harsh marine conditions

Multitechnic was founded at the beginning of the 1970s to create high quality artworks and decorative items in a range of metals. The same high-definition process that had recently been developed for manufacturing silicon chips was found to be effective for etching into metals. To this day we use the same technology, although we have improved the process to produce better results when etching metals such as brass and stainless steel.

Marine Signage is one of the most challenging environments for signage. We asked Colin Edge. Managing Director at Multitechnic, the demands that Marine Signage faces. Colin tells us, "When you go for a stroll on the deck of a cruise ship, you expect the look of a good quality hotel. You also expect that nice hotel to float across the seas, taking you to the beautiful fjords of Norway, or around the Caribbean islands in tropical sunshine. It is harder to imagine a more challenging environment for signage, but signage is necessary around decks, stairs, pool-sides, for safety and for information, and it has to look nice."

With huge exposure to the elements, Colin tells us about how a Marine environment affects traditional forms of signage. "As if a normal marine environment wasn't enough of a challenge, the decks of cruise ships tend to be washed down with salt water, sometimes twice a day, and in tropical sunshine, that leaves salty residues that dry to super-concentrated paint stripper in minutes, day after day, week after week. There is no hiding from the sun on a ship that sails in all directions, and over most of the planet that sun will bleach colours much faster than it will in cloudy old Britain, a chilly 55° north of the equator."

Colin continues "At this point, your experienced sign designer starts to think of 316 marine grade stainless

steel; that must do the trick, it is after all stainless steel designed for the marine environment, clue's in the name. Well that is true to a certain extent, but what about the graphics? Any print will come off almost immediately, and if you etch in the graphics, you need to fill the graphics with paint, and anybody with experience of painting metals of any type in a marine environment will know that the paint will be destroyed, and there is nothing you can do to stop it. You could use vinyl, but once that salt gets under the edges, even on a microscopic scale, a hideous peeling sign is inevitable."

The cruise operators want attractive signage that will last three years before requiring replacement, that is their expectation, and if you can offer that, they will be happy. Multitechnic have developed a signage standard, specifically for use in extreme marine environments, and much of the deck signage to this specification installed as far back as 2016 is still in service. For safety signage in colour that is also of a good visual quality, next to swimming pools on the decks of cruise ships, that is quite outstanding, and the same signage works for swimming pools on land too.

### Technology at the heart of Anoprinted Aluminium

"The technology at the heart of the product is anoprinted aluminium." Digital Anoprinting is a process used to print aluminium. The process starts by using a special, 'open pore' aluminium, which is permeable to the inks used to print it using a specialist printer. Once the aluminium has been printed, the print is then 'sealed' in a post treatment water tank, like a very hot bath. This process seals the open pores creating an extremely durable print which is resistant to extreme wear, chemicals and solvents, even with heavy use. Unlike a direct digital surface print, anoprinting has a completely smooth finish due to the print being under the surface, adding to its superior durability.

"This process creates full colour graphics inside the hard anodised surface of aluminium sheet. Like any other full colour process it will suffer from colour fade if exposed to intense sunlight, but full colour is not important. For safety and directional signage, black and some spot colours are all that is required, and Multitechnic have developed and tested some strong colours that will give an acceptable life in these conditions."

Colin continues his explanation of the methods that Multitechnic have developed

themselves, "we have also developed a unique process for preventing corrosion of the edges of the signs, by applying a conversion coating to passivate the aluminium."

### The right fixings

It is not only the sign, but the fixings that are important. Due to the salt-heavy environment, we asked Colin about the right fixing for a Marine environment. "Signs are almost always fixed onto sound painted surfaces using a specialist 3M adhesive, which Multitechnic supplies on the back of their signs. If any signs must be mechanically fixed, brass or bronze screws can be used, but steel or stainless steel screws must not be used for any aluminium based product. The same specification that is used for exterior signage on ships is useful in harbours, sea fronts, and other marine environments where adhesive fixing is probably not an option, Multitechnic keep a range of fixings in stock for these applications.

Anoprinted aluminium signs of this type are also used in the rail environment, including inside tunnels where all signage must comply with Low Smoke Zero Halogen (LSZH) requirements. This is something that may be specified for signage inside ships, submarines, and oil rigs, so anoprinted aluminium is also useful for these environments."

The conditions between internal and external marine signage differ greatly, yet there still has to be considerations for robust signs. Colin elaborates, "Signage for the interiors of ships does not have to endure the extreme conditions experienced on deck, but it is still a marine environment. Brass is often requested, but really is not a good idea. Lacquers that look effective on brass do not last well, even in the seemingly harmless environments inside ships. Etched 316 grade stainless steel, especially with mixed use of satin and polished finishes can make beautiful signage that is also durable."

Colin expands on this, "Anoprinted aluminium, away from the glare of the sun, opens up the possibilities of full colour signage that is also physically robust, for wayfinding on ships where surface prints would be too easily damaged. Remember that people moving about on moving ships, and their bags and clothing, come into contact with walls and the signage that is on those walls much more than on dry land, so signs need to be robust."

Any signs for use in marine environments, decorative or functional, need some careful thought to ensure that what you supply to your customer will be up to the job. Multitechnic have a lot of expertise in this field, and for other challenging environments."



# Rudd Macnamara, 125 years of leading the way in screen printing and manufacturing


Rudd Macnamara have been in the printing industry for over 125 years, and are a leading UK based screen printer and manufacturer of bespoke printed components. From quality certified metal and plastic nameplates through to pump clips, keg badges, signs and vacuum formed products, they print onto a huge range of metal and plastic substrates to meet the needs of your industry.

We spoke to Graham Caunce, Director, about Rudd Macnamara's experience with supplying marine signage. As one of the most challenging of environments, there are special requirements that marine signage must adhere to. Graham tells us, "Rudd Macnamara has a very wide range of equipment on site which means we can adapt quickly to our client's needs.

All the processes we refer to are manufactured in house. We have a very wide range of equipment and substantial material and consumable stock. The bonus of a highly experienced workforce within the industry means that the expectations of our Marine clients can be met."

Graham expands on the services provided by Rudd Macnamara and the process required to create durable and high quality marine signage. He tells us, "The Voyager sign shown is an anodised sign which has been four colour process printed. The four colour process print is carried out on bespoke printed manufactured in Switzerland and uses Epson print heads."



Anodised inks sit under the surface, are UV resistant and graffiti proof.

Graham elaborates about the result of the anodised print and its ability for a long lasting finish. "Very high resolution images can be produced with this equipment and the results are spectacular. The anodised inks are effectively indelible and are "part" of the underlying aluminium sheet. The print has excellent UV resistance and is graffiti proof in that paints can be removed with thinners without removing the print. No overlaminate is required.



Great for signage on board all kinds of marine vessels but also good for exterior use for any sort of interpretation panel or panels where there is a high level of human traffic. The process has good fire safety credentials as no vinyl is involved."


We asked, other than marine signage, was there any other area where this process can be used. Graham says "In addition to cruise liners anodised signs have also been used at Castle Espie in Northern Ireland and the Wildfowl and Wetlands Trust and also for very striking images of the Vulcan bomber for the "Vulcan to the Skies" charity.

Rudd Macnamara also supply chemical etched signs as a form of marine signage. Graham explains the process of how these signs are manufactured. "The fluid control signs shown in the image are made using an etch and fill process whereby the wording is etched out of stainless steel and filled with a paint.

The whole piece is over lacquered with a high quality robust stoving lacquer to protect the metal and the image. The lacquer is stoved a high temperature to create a solid robust finish. The stainless steel used is a marine grade with a higher chromium content than the standard stainless steel. The badge is cut out in our press shop using our fibre laser cutter and then finally is formed to shape to fit into a recess on the vessel."

To conclude, Graham tells us, "These are not the only solutions Rudd Macnamara can supply. We are ready to provide the solutions as required by our clients."





### Made-to-Measure

Speaking to Julie, Director at Fabricut, we asked her what kind of sign trays do Fabricut supply to their customers. Julie tells us, "A tray sign is an essential component in sign manufacturing which can be built-upon with the addition of built-up letters, flat cut or illuminated push through letters, vinyl lettering, shapes and logos, creating a prominent and memorable solution for your customers and their brands.

All our tray signs are made-to-measure to exact requirements and they often form the foundation of most signage projects."

Julie also supplied us with a sample of a push through sign tray, supplied by Fabricut. As the name implies, the letters look like they've been pushed through the surface of the sign material. The frame for the letters on a push through sign is an aluminum or aluminium composite box. The surface layer is fret-cut, through which the acrylic letters "push" out of, giving it a stand-out, signature look.

#### **Manufacture**

As Fabricut manufacture their signs, we ask Julie how businesses approach Fabricut and what is required to complete an order for a tray sign. Julie says "At Fabricut, we've been manufacturing signs for nearly 35 years and can work with your own supplied artwork or we can help create the designs on your behalf.

Our sign trays are made using a blend of computer control and a hand crafted approach. This ensures the accuracy and precision of our signage production for a superb high-end finish. They can be supplied as a bare unfinished component, semi-prepared, or as a fully completed fascia sign with all the bells and whistles ready to install."

#### **Materials**

Supplying to multiple markets means that there must be a variety of requests mad by customers. Asking Julie about what material Fabricut offers to their customers, Julie tells us, "We manufacture our trays out of aluminium composite material (ACM), or aluminium.

ACM comes in a range of standard RAL colours and metallic finishes. The corners are reinforced for extra strength.

Aluminium is powder-coated to standard RAL colours or it can be wet sprayed if a specific non-standard colour is required. Corners are welded and dressed.



### Applelec Sign - Sign Trays with a difference

From its early beginnings as a general metal fabricator, it became evident for Applelec that there was a gap in the market for a trade signage manufacturer. Over the years Applelec has used its market intuition to embrace growing trends in LED and lens technology and game changing equipment such as our CNC and high-definition plasma cutter back in the 1990's. With staff increasing from 2 to over 70, and a 6-acre manufacturing facility, Applelec have grown from strength to strength.

Speaking with Rachel Gould, PR & Marketin Manager at Applelec. We asked her what makes Applelec so different. Rachel tells us, "Sign Trays are one of the most popular and versatile products in the sign makers' arsenal. Forming the base for many other types of signage such as fascias, totems, projecting signs and more, it is crucial we continue to evolve our offering to ensure it can be applied to a diverse range of applications and meets our customers' changing needs.

At Applelec we benefit from having the talent and facilities to research and develop new ideas and push the boundaries of what is possible in signage fabrication. This varies from modifying traditional techniques to utilising the fastemerging sustainable materials coming down the supply chain. This had led us to develop a number of ECO products through our award winning Applelec ECO Pledge but also innovate and challenge the way we have historically done things and sign trays are no exception."

### The slimmest sign trays on the market

One of Applelec's unique selling points within the signage industry is its slimline light panel. We asked Rachel how Applelec were able to manufacture the slimmest sign tray available to the market. Rachel tells us, "Historically, the depths of illuminated sign trays have been dictated by the choice of backlighting solutions, whether LEDs or even florescent tubes, these all require a bulkier depth to house them and avoid spotting. Having our own architectural lighting division and in-house factory, we tested combining sign trays with our flagship product, our Applelec

LED Light Sheet and its environmentally friendly counterpart, Green Applelec LED Light Sheet. This slimline light panel allowed us to reduce fabrication depths of our sign trays from a typical minimum depth of 100mm to a depth of 28mm, helping us create one of the slimmest sign trays available on the market and the benefits don't stop there.

Manufactured from recycled and recyclable acrylic, the highly sustainable Green Applelec LED Light Sheet benefits from its highly energy efficient LEDs, which achieve 175 lumens per watt, reducing running costs without compromising on brightness. Its unique patented thermal management system means our panels

run cool to touch, making it a reliable and safe option to use in tight, enclosed spaces, such as our slimline sign trays, a feature that is unparalleled by anything else on the market. This opens up a world of application possibilities, allowing sign companies to fit sign trays into spaces they couldn't do before, without compromising on brightness or safety."

### Thinking outside the sign tray

With the slimline light panel, we wanted to know if Applelec had more specifcs about the slimlne range. Rachel expands on a particularly difficult project that Applelec were able to complete for a distinguished client. Rachel says, "We are also seeing a lot more decorative sign trays coming through, especially from the retail industry, which is pushing our team to think outside the box to make our trade customers' creative designs a reality. One such project was for a luxury retail design within Selfridges, London. Applelec were tasked with revamping the Trish McEvoy concession stand and required a number of decorative, stencil cut, illuminated sign trays, lightboxes and acrylic letters. Our team were challenged to come up with a way to create a sign tray with neon style push through lettering that had exceptionally narrow serif.

Normally this is something that is not possible through traditional letter manufacturing methods, however the team took our NeonLux lettering range and experimented with different modifications until they came up with the perfect solution that maintained the flowing style of the letters and intricate stroke width required, whilst still giving the customer the neon look, they wanted.

The end result was a decorative, stencil and fret cut sign tray, painted in-house with modified push through neon letters. Applelec LED Light Sheets in warm 3000K was then used to illuminate the series of sign trays and light boxes, perfectly matching the opulence of this golden, art deco style design scheme, which also benefited from its slimline depths and consistent brightness."

### Creating the right fit

Rachel continues with another bespoke solution for Liverpool's Red Radisson hotel. Rachel says, "Another example of creative sign tray manufacturing comes from Liverpool's Red Radisson, Grade-II listed hotel. Signs Express Central Lancashire tasked the Applelec team to manufacture the external signage they had designed that included an illuminated sign tray, two sets of built-up letters and plaque for the new onsite Stoke restaurant. Due to the building's Grade-II listed status, creative solutions were needed to allow the sign trays fixing rails to bypass the protruding trim of the entrance archway. Signs Express Central Lancashire asked the team to create adjustable fixing rails allowing them to navigate this installation challenge and working closely with the Applelec team, we were able to fabricate a solution, matching their spec, which worked perfectly.

Due to this sign tray sitting in a glass entrance way, it required the front and reverse painting black with a contrasting pantone matched red trim, achieved in our in-house paintshop. The corporate logo was then stencil cut into the face of the sign tray with 3mm opal acrylic backer and 5mm opal acrylic inlays, so that the logo sits discreetly 2mm proud of the sign tray.

SloanLED VL4 LEDs were selected for the sign trays illumination, for its ultra-wide radiation pattern, impressive light output, reliable lifetime rating (>54,000 hours to L80 at ≤50°C ambient) and industry leading 10-year parts and 5-year labour assist warranty, that delivers both value and performance. Illumination was further enhanced by the painted white interior tray, providing crisp, bright illumination, enhancing the Red Radisson corporate logo against the slick black sign tray.

To conclude, Rachel tells us about how through these bespoke pieces of work, Applelec are adapting and changing to suit the needs for the future of the business. "The variety of techniques and intricacies in each of these projects were a welcomed opportunity for the Applelec team to flex their quality in-house fabrication capabilities and creative thinking. Working closely with our trade customers is key to creating innovative solutions to ensure we can make their briefs a reality. The adaptability of sign trays offers a solid but versatile foundation for sign makers, but it is creative manufacturing and innovative ideas that will continue to evolve this tradition and help us meet the everchanging needs of our valued customers."



# Aluminium or Aluminium Composite (ACM) trays - What is best?

### **Composite or Aluminium?**

Ashby Trade Sign Supplies are based in a 30,000 sq. foot factory just off the M3 in Hampshire. Over the course of our 20 years in the industry, Ashby have built up a highly extensive range of machinery, skills and knowledge that enable them to supply attractive, durable and relevant systems within the UK and Ireland.

Speaking with Steve Nicholas, General Manager at Ashby, he gives his perspective on the difference between ACM (Aluminium Composite Material) and aluminium tray signs. Steve tells us, "As a supplier of both Aluminium and Composite sign trays we are often asked which is the better product.

Our bias as a manufacturer of Aluminium Signage inevitably falls on the side of aluminium trays, in our opinion the scope for manufacturing far outweighs that of composite. Aluminium can be shaped, welded, curved and coated to almost any colour, whereas composite is limited to straight edge folding or shaped edges with no returns. And, if you require a particular colour, composite is difficult to paint due to the processes used, generally requiring the trays to be baked. Another consideration is the lifespan of composite, it is significantly shorter than aluminium therefore perfect for temporary signage. We find that most purchases of composite trays generally happen because of a pricing issue, and no thought to overall cost in the long term."

Despite the limitations to ACM, Steve continues to tell us the pros and cons for both Composite and Aluminium trays.


### **Pros for Composite panels**

"Below are some Pros and Cons for using either Composite or Aluminium Trays.

Composite is lighter than aluminium and has a smoother paint finish. When reverse routed with a groove and folded, the external corners have a crisper sharp edge. Application of Prints to the face and edges is easier as this is done prior to folding.

#### **Cons for Composite panels**

Composite is not recyclable so ends up



in landfill. To manufacture composite travs material is routed from the rear of the panel prior to folding, this reduces the overall strength of the material at the folds (normally 50% of the material is removed). To save money some people use inferior grades of composite with aluminium Skins as low as 0.1mm (Composite Skins for tray manufacture should never be below 0.3mm thickness.) The Faces of composite trays are more susceptible to dent damage. ACM Holds no fire rating. Composite trays cannot be welded, which prohibits shaped returns or curved faces. Due to the manufacturing process composite trays do not suit open backed systems."

#### **Pros for Aluminium**

Aluminium is completely recyclable. Stronger than composite and harder wearing. Easy to paint, shape, fold, curve and weld. Has fire resistance.

#### **Cons for Aluminium**

Aluminium is heavier than composite. Application of prints to the face and edges is more difficult. Visually, when installed there is very little difference between Aluminium and Composite Trays, although aluminium will last significantly longer, it can easily be repurposed when required with a new coat of paint and some graphics, making it far more cost effective over the duration of its lifespan, whereas composite only offers a short term saving."

Nathan tells us, "Digital signs are created using a combination of machinery, technology, and software. The process typically involves the following steps:



# Ricoh and ISA UK: how sign & display businesses can build for a bright future



RICOH & ISA UK's Podcast series hosted a series of new trends that were very much the topic for SIgn & DIgital exhibition at the NEC

#### Impact on the industry since Covid

There is no understating the impact that the pandemic had on the sign and display markets. Thankfully, both sectors are now well on the road to recovery, but there are still certain challenges that remain for sign-makers and other companies in the industry.

The pandemic changed the way almost everyone works, not just within the sign and print sectors, but also further afield. Whether this was simply the way we hold meetings, with many now taking place over a Zoom or Teams call rather than in-person, or how we access certain items in the supply chain, adapting the way that your business operates is critical to long-term success.

Tim Carter, Commercial Print Sales Director at Ricoh Graphic Communications, recently sat down with ISA-UK CEO Craig Brown to discuss the sign industry's future as part of Ricoh's 'Anything in Print' podcast series.

#### Working together

Titled 'A Sign of Things to Come', the session took place shortly after the Sign & Digital UK 2023 event, where a host of

new trends were very much the topic of discussion for both visitors and exhibitors at the NEC.

ISA-UK oversaw the 'SDUK Explains Lounge' at the exhibition, where more than 30 speakers took part in sessions covering some of the key talking points in the industry at present.

Among some of the core takeaways highlighted here, as well as wider afield across the show floor, was the willingness for manufacturers and suppliers to work together to develop solutions that will support sign and display companies in the long run and allow them to grow their businesses by taking on a wider range of work.

"It seemed that suppliers are much happier to work together and acknowledge that their machine didn't do everything that the customer wanted, and that you might have two or three different brands to work together," Craig Brown said.

"I haven't really seen that before because previously if you went for a particular supplier, then that was the total focus. Whereas now, there seems to be much more openness about how people would work together, and what happens when you are using various supply chains."

#### Make a community

This collaborative approach carries over from manufacturers and suppliers working together, to the actual sign businesses themselves supporting each other in order to drive growth across the industry. Being a part of a specialist trade group like ISA-UK will not only put you in touch with other companies in the market, but also grant access to a wide range of resources that could help you progress.

"I'd like to think we are there to try and help the industry," Craig said. "I don't think we often get recognised for what we do. I would say we represent around 300 members in total, and some of the bigger sign members in the fraternity, but I think the industry can become a bit blasé.

"I'd love as a trade association to have manufacturers coming to me to tell me where they think the next trends will be and why they're investing in this particular print technology, because it starts a discussion. And if that discussion is headed by someone from a specific supplier, then the person reading would probably go and ask them first. There's a benefit for the manufacturer to give us the information as well.

"Let's make it a community; we listen to what you want, but we need our members to contribute as well."

# Ultraflex Europe mark 30 year supply partnership with Macroart

Print media supplier, Ultraflex Europe, is marking a dual milestone. It's been 30 years since they established the business and 30 years supplying one of the UK's leading branding and signage specialists, Macroart, in St. Neots, Cambridgeshire.

The anniversaries are closely linked as Utraflex Europe was initially set up within the original Macroart premises in 1993 to supply print media for their 5m wide format Vutek printer. Since this time, these businesses have always been located close to each other and Ultraflex Europe continues to be a leading supplier to Macroart and the wider market.

"The proximity of Ultraflex has always been very handy and cost effective for the delivery of our 3m and 5m wide media, but today this has grown in significance as it dramatically assists our sustainability drive to reduce our carbon footprint." Said Matt Guise Sales Director at Macroart.

Macroart was started by John Walker in 1992 as a wide format print company. John previously worked for Vutek in North America, had sold printing machines across Europe before setting up Macroart with the first 5m wide format machine in the UK. With no local suppliers, he approached Ultraflex in the US with a view to supplying 5m wide media for his new machine, and as a result Ultraflex Europe was born.

Mirroring the wide format market in the UK, Macroart has had continual growth since this time, and they have retained their place as one of the largest wide format printers in the country. They now reside on one site, a 54,000 sq foot facility, that hosts two 5m UV machines and two 3m Dye Sublimation print engines, along with an array of finishing equipment. They also own a framing business on the same site, Aluvista, that produces bespoke aluminium POS structures and light boxes, as a lot of what Macroart produce is for live events (Air Shows, Conferences & Exhibitions) and retail.

Macroart went through an MBO in 2014 and the business has expanded and diversified over the years culminating today in an annual turnover of c: £14m. The business has become something of a specialist in Dye Sub Printing, which is traditionally a difficult process to get right,

and they have spent lots of time testing materials to understand the shrinking and stretch factors to perfect the process. As a result, they now house their dye sub department in a climate-controlled area and an experienced stitching team within the finishing department to produce silicone edge graphics. They consider this a critical part of the process, as the finished product needs to be millimeter perfect to fit display systems with tight tolerances.

Whilst Ultraflex Europe is not the only media supplier to Macroart today, it's impressive that they were not only the first to supply Macroart, but that 30 years on that supplier-customer relationship is close as ever.

"We have always been impressed at the experience and knowledge of materials from the team at Ultraflex. Some of the media they supply is the same they supplied 30 years ago and we appreciate that consistency. It's important for us to be confident that the material will perform well and that it has been tried and tested by us. The key strengths of Ultraflex Europe for us are locality, expertise, consistency of materials and their honesty." Said Matt Guise. "There is a lot of smoke and mirrors and greenwashing in the industry, and Ultraflex are consistently honest at answering the questions we pose. We purchase both UV and Dye Sub roll to roll media from Ultraflex. We still buy a lot of

PVC products from them and as we are zero to landfill at Macroart and they are close by there is little C02 use to obtain the material. We print, fit, and at the end of the event we de-rig, bail and palletise all our waste PVC for recycling. When you compare this to other 'non-PVC' or 'sustainable' materials, the carbon used in delivery can often outweigh the benefits."

Macroart has embraced a sustainability drive and have a team of six internally that focus on it, including a sustainability consultant, who is an industry expert, and have a green energy company on board too. Matt explains that their biggest wins in carbon neutrality are with the materials that they buy, so a strong relationship with their material suppliers is playing an increasingly important part in making an environmental difference.

Matt concludes: "We are all about long term relationships with suppliers and Ultraflex is proof of that. We have never been in a situation where they have run out of material, they have performed well over a long period of time, and we expect our partnership to continue to thrive. We are currently testing new textile material from them to offer within our dye sub range and as usual with Ultraflex materials the results are looking very promising."

## The IPIA visits No10. to protect print

As parts of sustained efforts to grow the UK print industry, the Independent Print Industries Association (IPIA) paid a visit to No 10 Downing Street, where its Chair, Charles Rogers, met with special advisors to the Prime Minister Rishi Sunak.

On the agenda for discussion with the special business and political advisors was a detailed overview of the place of the UK as top-6 global print producer, its responsibility for nearly 8% of total UK manufacturing output, and the critical part it plays in the social, cultural and economic fabric of the country. Print and paper's role in developing sustainable technology and its contribution to the advancement of the circular economy was also highlighted.

The IPIA also set out the challenges that are inhibiting the growth and competitiveness of UK print and paper, before presenting a package of structural and strategic support requests. A case was also put forward for the print, paper and allied sectors to be recognised as an 'industry of strategic value' – a term that describes industries that play a fundamental role in the economic health and competitiveness of the nation.

"The opportunity to participate in this meeting presented itself at short notice, and I was honoured to represent the

IPIA on behalf of print and paper at No 10 Downing Street," says Charles, who continues: "Meeting with special advisors, who report to the PM, was a critical and rare opportunity to push our agenda for all those involved with print and paper in the UK.

#### Working in partnership

The special advisors welcomed the information and valued the dialogue, which gave them a chance not only to learn key facts about one of the UK's few remaining world-class manufacturing industries, but how it can be supported to grow with Government assistance.

The meeting was facilitated by Puneet Gupta from PG Paper Company Ltd, as part of its ongoing initiatives to support the paper and print industry in the UK, who comments: "In today's fast-paced digital world, the paper and print industry faces a range of challenges that require innovation, collaboration, and adaptability to overcome – it's important to have open and honest conversations about navigating these. By bringing together stakeholders from various sectors of the industry we look to develop strategies to overcome the challenges and support growth."

Charles adds: "The meeting represents the

culmination of years of hard work spent talking to Government, creating and attending industry events, networking and beating the drum for print and paper by the IPIA."

Charles concludes: "Both advisors expressed positivity regarding follow up meetings and currently we are looking forward to a return visit – where we can expand on suggestions to aid UK print and paper supported by the GPMA."

# Ashby Trade Sign Supplies cost reduction analysis for the signage industry

Price increases, Cost of living crisis, Inflation, Interest Rates, Brexit, Global Pandemic, War in Ukraine and Energy prices. All these things have dominated the news and our lives for the last 5 years.

Speaking with Steve Nicholas, General Manager at Ashby, about the impact this has on the signage industry, Steve tells us. "The entire industry has struggled with rising costs. Steve expands on the volatility of the current market. "We fully understand the implications of raising prices out of necessity, something that we, along with everyone else in the industry have had to do to keep our business running and the products flowing. As the markets have

been so volatile, we even found ourselves in a position for the first time in our history where quotes were only valid for 30 days due to the instability of global markets, and cost rates for raw materials changing on a daily basis."

Whilst accepting the inevitability of market cost increases, Steve tells us how Ashby are monitoring costs for the customer's sake. "We have managed to maintain all other costs through investment in machinery and processes, streamlining our production facility and upgrading our systems and IT infrastructure, ensuring that running costs were kept to a minimum, ultimately reducing overall profit.

As our costs went up, we promised not to profiteer, and as soon as was commercially viable we would reduce costs and return savings back to our customers. Finally, it would appear amidst all the doom and gloom the global markets are starting to stabilise, and we are more

than happy to announce that this saving is being passed on to you, our customers."

Steve concluded by saying, "by the time our customers read this, they will be seeing the benefits of these reductions, and our hope is that other suppliers will follow the trend. Moving forward we will continue to carefully monitor our prices and continue to pass on reductions as they become available.

We would like to thank all our customers for their understanding through these difficult times."






