

Event Technology Group invests in UV LED Mimaki technology from CMYUK

Event Technology Group has invested in a Mimaki UJV55-320 UV LED dedicated 3.2m roll-to-roll printer and a Mimaki UCJV300-160 UV LED 1.6m integrated printer and cutter from CMYUK. The installation ensures that the business will no longer have to outsource any of its soft signage / textile printed work, saving both time and money.

The new equipment has been installed at the group's scenic production company, **Set.Build.Create**, which provides a wide selection of set design and graphic capabilities including exhibition stands, large format print, experiential services set for theatres and stages. Additionally, the business supports all other companies within the Berkshire-based group with signage mostly for the events and exhibitions sector. However, with this new investment the group intends to further its reach to a far wider market.

Super-wide capabilities

The key driver for installing the Mimaki UJV55-320 UV LED printer in-house was to establish greater control and efficiency.

"We print soft signage/textile left, right, and centre, and were keen to increase efficiencies that the tight deadlines of live events dictate. We were spending thousands outsourcing. We were finding that clients' artwork at times required really short timelines that meant they had to be printed last minute. We could then be faced with rush charges, you can find you're paying out up to £5 per square metre, which when you're printing at volume really adds up. By bringing a 3.2m printer in-house, we can work up to the wire, not be beholden to anyone else's time agendas, and importantly for the client, stay within an acceptable budget," says Chris Norman, Founder and CEO, Event Technology Group.

"Post COVID, we've noticed that brands are moving away from Foamex and moving towards textile printing and complete wraps. We were finding that we were having real trouble securing printing slots for our outsourced work," adds Sarah Hamilton, Operations Director.

The Mimaki UJV55-320 delivers superwide UV LED high quality print at volume. This 3.2m wide dedicated roll-to-roll printer is suitable for multiple applications including banners, retail displays, exhibitions, events, window graphics, and more. The addition of twin-roll simultaneous printing ensures enhanced throughput speeds and increased productivity. It offers a resolution of up to 1200dpi and incorporates Mimaki's Advance Pass System core technology that utilises an algorithm pattern to reduce banding, for superior output, even at higher speeds.

Mimaki integrated print and cut

The installation of the Mimaki UCJV300-160 UV LED printer cutter replaces a 1.6m wide HP Latex printer and an old Mimaki cutter. "We were in the process of decommissioning the HP Latex when we saw the offers on the Mimaki equipment from CMYUK. With the UCJV300-160 being a printer and cutter in one, we've been able to slim down, and now we can produce white and spot varnish on banners and other smaller print jobs," says Chris.

The Mimaki Clear ink capability has already demonstrated its worth. Originally a campaign for a well-known soft drink required print to be laminated to board and covered with Perspex so that the final image looked like a fridge. Instead, the clear ink was applied to create the effect, negating the need for lamination and Perspex.

"When we ordered the Mimaki, I wasn't aware at the time how much the clear ink would be used, but I knew it was unique," says Chris.

Due to the high temperature required in the printing process, Latex printers can only output to a limited range of media, In addition, the heat required utilises more energy and therefore increases running costs.



The new equipment will run alongside an existing Mimaki flatbed printer. Additional staff including a new Head of Print will be joining, and for the first time the group will be offering its print production services to the wider trade.

Says Chris, "We didn't just buy the new equipment for internal purposes, not everyone has got a 3.2m printer sitting about. We're also in a unique position where we're not just a printing company, however, we want to keep the printer busy and selling to the trade was a big driver. Having white and clear ink on the smaller printer/cutter was an active decision too, allowing us to offer a real differentiator."

For nearly twenty years, Poppy Signs has served the North West of England with a complete and comprehensive sign design, build and installation service.

"We try to do things a bit differently," says Dave McDonald, Managing Director of Poppy Signs, "We sell design, aesthetics and quality in a full wrap-around service that handles all our customers' signage requirements and challenges. We regularly invest in the professional development of our people, as well as in new equipment, and this has contributed to regular and sustainable growth of the business over many years."

A key part of Poppy Signs' success is a focus on delivering the best local solutions. "We have never tried to be a signage company looking to deliver national rollouts. We focus on delivering a comprehensive and customer-focused service to the Northwest, covering Merseyside, Greater Manchester, Lancashire and Cumbria. We are also developing a range of e-commerce sites on the back of our recent investments, and these will be rolled out over the next 12 months."

Liyu Hybrid investment

During 2022, and following a period where the company had offered significant help and support to customers during the pandemic, Poppy Signs began looking at making an important investment in new printing technology. "We had an Arizona flatbed, which was a great workhorse, but it had a few years under its belt, and its relatively slow speed was causing a major bottleneck in our workflow. It was time to go to the market for our next printing solution, which we knew would be critical to our business development and what we could deliver for our customers," says Dave.

With such an important investment, Dave wasn't leaving anything to chance. "We looked at just about every solution out there and put several machines through their paces. We were looking at 3.2m printing and decided we wanted a hybrid machine to give us the versatility of both flatbed and roll-to-roll for better space management and more flexible working. After several demos and extensive research, we decided to purchase a Liyu Platinum Q3 Hybrid."

They gave a great demonstration, but I know that a good demo is never the full story. This was going to be the first of this model sold in the UK, so we needed to put a lot of due diligence into the product and also the brand itself."

Dave looked to other countries, such as Italy and France, where Liyu is wellestablished as a major brand in UV printing. "In those countries, Liyu is as big a brand name as anyone! I looked further across other territories, and I quickly saw that even though Livu didn't have as familiar a name in the UK, it was clearly a company of real substance, with a huge installed base around the world. I felt it was a matter of time before Liyu established its name in the UK. Over the last year, Eddie and the team have done a great job of getting the name and the products out there, and I don't think it will be long until Livu is on most people's shortlist when looking at UV printing.'

Poppy Signs also had the assurance of Liyu UK's support and technical pedigree that the company had enjoyed for many years. "Another important element that helped us to mitigate the risk was that we had already dealt with the company for a long time, and what has always stood out is their total commitment to supporting our needs. It doesn't matter what we asked; they have always done their best to sort us out and help where they can, and I saw no reason why this wouldn't continue were we to invest in the Liyu printer. As it turned out, we were absolutely right about that. Their support has been brilliant."

He adds, "It also helped that I took a highly detailed look under the bonnet of the printer and what I found was exceptional build quality. The individual components were excellent, and the whole construction was very solid. The Platinum Q3 is a machine of real substance."

Working with the new printer

Installation was very straightforward, as the Liyu team spent lots of time with Poppy Signs to make sure everything went smoothly. "It was an easy transition to the Platinum, and Liyu were very helpful throughout. With any new machine, you need to build up a library of standard profiles, so in those first few weeks, we established some standardised settings. The machine has so much flexibility it can be fine-tuned to deliver exactly the right balance of speed and quality. These settings can be preserved for use with specific media and applications, and once we had done these for our most common uses, we were flying."

In the year since the Liyu Platinum Q3 Hybrid was installed, Poppy Signs has been able to put in place some major changes to its business. Dave explains, "Some applications have really taken off thanks to the Liyu. Wallpaper, in particular, has been transformed. We previously provided narrow-format wallpaper, but now we can offer full-width output that can be installed more easily with fewer drops and far fewer joins. We marketed this very heavily across our customer base, and it has been hugely successful for us. In this area, speed and quality are vitally important, and that is what the Liyu gives us in spades."

He continues, "We have also increased the amount of print we are providing

for promotional events. Our workflow bottleneck has been removed, and we can produce hundreds of square metres of great-quality print quickly and accurately. We rarely use our latex machine now because the Platinum is faster, wider and considerably cheaper to run – both in terms of energy and ink costs."

On the back of the additional capabilities of the Livu, Poppy Signs is in the process of launching dedicated e-commerce websites. "Selling online is something we have been working towards for some time, and the Liyu has enabled us to do this. It provides the capacity, production speeds and versatility to allow us to offer a broad range of products that we can sell directly from the websites. Because it is cold LED-cured printing, the Liyu will print to virtually any media with no issues, and this flexibility is what you need for successful online sales. We have been through a discovery process of looking at all sorts of media from many different suppliers to see what we can print on successfully, and the Q3 can handle pretty much all of them," says Dave.

In conclusion, Dave predicts great things for Poppy Signs and Liyu UK. "This has been such a good investment for us. The Liyu has transformed our business and allowed us to increase markets, revenues and margins. In terms of quality and value, there is nothing that comes near the Liyu printers. I have no doubt that they will soon be one of the mainstream suppliers of UV and digital cutting machines in the UK, just as they are in other countries."

Michael explains: "I started Simply Beautiful Print from my home office in 2011, outsourcing all the production and we now reside in a facility that houses an Agfa Anapurna H3200i LED UV Printer, an Agfa Avinci CX3200 Dye Sublimation Printer, an HP 800W Latex Printer and a Canon iGAF Printer. To support these engines, we also have a Kongsberg C64 Edge, Klieverik Calender, Neschen Coldlam Laminator, CWT Application Table plus Sewing Machine with Conveyor Line.

This growth hasn't come overnight, and we have worked in a few smaller units over the years, including one we shared with an ambulance for a while. But we have grown steady and consistently, monitored the market and outsourced till we had the volume to bring it in house. We now have a loyal customer base that trust in us and we have a lot of capacity and are selfcontained which is important as it means that we control both the timing and quality for our customers."

Michael was introduced to Agfa through a 'Red Carpet Event' that they held back in 2016. He visited the Agfa Head Quarters

ESP Smile installs third Canon Colorado 1650 from CMYUK

The purchase of a third Colorado was to ensure the continued smooth 24/7 delivery of canvasses in the light of increasing output volumes.

The business launched its on-demand service in 2017 with the purchase of a Canon Colorado 1640 that output up to 50,000 canvasses per year. Increased volumes led to the purchase of a Colorado 1650 in 2020, which saw output rise to 250,000 canvases per annum, the new system allows ESP to output 350,000 canvases per annum.

"We bought the Canon Colorado rather than any other printer out there because we've found something that really works for us," says Simon Smogur, CEO, ESP Group.

"There's nothing like it out there in the market. It scores top marks for everything: capital costs, running costs, reliability, quality, and speed. People have asked why we haven't invested in a larger faster industrial printer, but then I'd have a single point of failure, and also if I ever needed it, I know Canon's service is second to none. Also, when you stretch printed canvas onto a frame, the stretcher bars have the ability to poke through on the corners, and where the print wraps over, a white line can appear, but not with UFabrik. We currently buy about 800 to 1000 rolls a year and rate its quality and consistency.

"We have a great relationship with CMYUK and if we continue to grow in large format, we will probably buy another Colorado. I have never ever had any issues with this printer, which is something you can never underestimate."

"Prior to installing these machines we would usually screen print, which meant taking the time to set up multiple screens, and then printing as many as 50 to make it cost effective. With the Gibson machine we can instantly print bespoke one-offs if required," he says.

"Our other method was roll printing on our Roland wide format machine, which meant leaving prints for 24 hours, laminating and then mounting, which was a time consuming two man job. The Gibson prints direct to substrate and dries instantly. Plus there's no mess and no waste."

Making the investment was a bold step for the small but growing company, so the economic case had to be made. "We hadn't heard of Gibson before but were very impressed at the demo site we visited," says Terry. "Compared to the alternatives it's cheaper to buy, but what's surprised us is how cheap it is to run. The inks cost less than screen printing or solvent inks, and we've calculated the power consumption is way less than expected at about £6 a day!"

The company's Almeida cutter is an important part of the package. "We used to buy materials cut to size, but now we can print multiple signs in one pass and the cutter does the rest. It's also versatile, we can change the blades, cut all kinds of shapes, sheets of stickers, and more."

Terry and his team are always looking for new sign markets. As much as half of their work comes from web orders which give a real-time indication of what is popular and a design-a-sign feature helps identify new trends. A feature of the Gibson machine gave Terry an idea which has huge potential. "We can layer the white ink which gives a raised surface and is ideal for producing braille signs," he says. "All together we're expecting this machine to contribute to a big rise in turnover in the coming year."

"I'm attempting the 721 Challenge to support the international conservation charity World Land Trust, of which Sir David Attenborough is a patron. I'm also proud to be an ambassador for the organisation.

"I am absolutely delighted with the final outcome of the printed decals and cannot wait to take on the Atlantic Challenge!"

Rachel continues, "2024 will see brands start to release information regarding the overall energy usage of their stores including concessions and so it is becoming increasingly important to be transparent about the energy usage of your signage, which will be under the microscope like never before. Those savvy amongst us will see this as an opportunity to be first to the table with solutions that anticipate this growing trend, which, if done right will give you an advantage on winning work with global brands."

Rachel elaborates with a case study of a retail store that has adopted the method of reducing its energy consumption. Rachel says, "Boots were early adopters, setting the electrical standards for display, through Design Conformity; specifying that they would only use Energy Rating: Grade C

LEDs or above within their schemes, with Next and M&S quickly following suite. This pushed, what was a focus on the trifecta of sustainable principles, which ensured designs considered how materials can be reduced, reused or recycled, to include a spotlight on energy consumption."

Interested to know how efficiency of an illuminated sign can be measured to demonstrate efficiency, Rachel tells us, "A lot of positive attributes must go into the design of illumination solutions to achieve lower energy consumption, which has multiple benefits for the environment. Energy consumption, therefore, is seen as a benchmark indicator of how effective and, in turn, how sustainable a solution is. For example, using an LED with cheap components tends to require more modules/lengths to creates the brightness needed for an effective illuminated sign. This drives up the energy consumption and in turn the LEDs tend to fail much sooner than a better-quality LED.

Lens technology is also key in throwing the illumination around the sign. Smaller beam angles mean more direct illumination; however, it means in bigger depths, considerably more modules would be required to ensure there is even illumination and no spotting. Consequently, this results in higher energy usage.

Lumens per watts (Im/w) is another useful indicator of energy efficiency of your LEDs with the higher the Im/w (ideally 100+), the more energy efficient the LEDs are.

These are all factors that build a picture of the overall efficiency of an illuminated sign and brands are looking for these indicators during the buying process, with transparency of energy consumption in mind. Making a conscious decision to choose more energy efficient illumination solutions and presenting this data in your quotes and sales pitches, will anticipate this need and stand you in good stead with your customers."

Lightening the load

As Rachel mentions, serious consideration has to be taken into account when considering cost-saving illuminations. We asked Rachel what Applelec were doing to stay ahead of the curve in this up and coming market. Rachel says, "With these trends in mind, Applelec have been working hard to be first to market with sustainable signage and illumination solutions, to help our trade customers be the first to offer these products to their customers.







IPIA heartened by investment in UK manufacturing's future

The business and manufacturing support policies announced in the Autumn Statement by the Chancellor are welcomed by the IPIA. They should collectively work to relieve a degree of economic pressure and stimulate investment for the print and paper industries.

Chairman of the IPIA, Charles Rogers comments: "In particular, we are very heartened to see the confirmed announcement of £11bn investment per year in UK manufacturing - through making the 'Full Expensing' scheme permanent. This means that print industry businesses and the supply chain that invest in the UK will reduce their tax by up to 25p for every £1 they spend on plant and machinery.

"The IPIA has focused on advocacy for the extension and expansion of this specific policy since April 2023 - across multiple tiers of Government - and we are very hopeful this will strengthen market confidence and stimulate long-term sector growth."

The IPIA also identified the following policy announcements as being

potentially beneficial for the UK print and paper industries. Each it is hoped will contribute to strengthening the hand of UK manufacturing, and are inline with the calls from the IPIA for such stimulus policies:

- The £4.5bn investment in advanced manufacturing and green energy in the form of subsidies and grants.
- New simplified research and development tax relief - combining the existing expenditure, credit and assembly schemes and a cut in tax by 6 percent for firms that make losses following research and development expenditure.
- £50m in funding to increase support for business taking on apprentices particularly in an engineering capacity.
- One year extension to the existing 75 percent business rates relief for retail, hospitality and leisure (This will support a key breadbasket print buying sector and hopefully work to uncork marketing investment).
- A freeze on the small business multiplier for business rates.
- A two percent cut to national insurance.

Charles concludes: "Our work to advocate on behalf of the UK print and paper industries will continue. We urge any sector businesses that wish to provide feedback on trading conditions or the impact of Government policies to do so. This information is kept confidential and is passed directly to The Government Department for Business and Trade."


